## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to taxation; imposing a tax on large trucks
- 2 as specified; directing the disposition of collected taxes;
- 3 requiring reporting; requiring rules; requiring studies;

14 **39-23-101.** Definitions.

15

- 16 (a) As used in this act unless otherwise specifically
- 17 provided:

1 2 (i) "Department" means the department of 3 transportation; 4 (ii) "Gross vehicle weight" means as defined by 5 W.S. 31-1-101(a)(vii); 6 7 (iii) "Gross vehicle weight rating" and "gross 8 9 combination weight rating," mean as defined by W.S. 31-7-102(a)(xxi) and (xxii); 10 11 (iv) "Instate miles" means as defined by W.S. 12 13 31-18-201; 14 (v) "Large truck" means any vehicle operated on 15 the public roads of this state which has a gross vehicle 16 17 weight rating or gross combination weight rating, gross vehicle weight or gross combination weight of forty 18 thousand (40,000) pounds or more, but not more than eighty 19 20 thousand (80,000) pounds; 21 22 (vi) "Weight rating" means gross vehicle weight rating or gross combined weight rating, whichever is 23

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5 39-23-102. Administration; confidentiality.

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The administration of this article is vested in 7 the department of transportation which shall prescribe the 8 9 reporting format and forms for the making of returns, and assessment and collection of taxes hereby imposed. 10 department 11 shall promulgate rules and regulations consistent with the provisions hereof as provided by the 12 Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act necessary to 13 enforcement of the provisions of this act. All records are 14 open to examination by the director of the state department 15

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of audit or his deputies.

(b) No state employee who by virtue of his employment has knowledge of the business affairs of any person filing or required to file any documents under this article shall make known its contents in any manner or permit any person to have access to any documents or information contained therein except as provided by law.

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1 39-23-103. Imposition.

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3 (a) There is levied and shall be collected a mileage

4 tax on all large trucks.

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6 (b) The tax shall be imposed for each mile that a

7 large truck travels on the public roads of Wyoming as

8 follows:

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10 (i) A tax of ten cents (\$.10) shall be imposed

11 on each large truck with a gross vehicle weight rating or

12 gross combined weight rating of eighty thousand (80,000)

13 pounds for each mile traveled on the public roads of

14 Wyoming during each taxable period;

15

16 (ii) For large trucks with a weight rating less

17 than eighty thousand (80,000) pounds, the taxable rate

18 shall be not less than one cent (\$.01) per mile, but shall

19 otherwise be reduced by the amount which results from

20 multiplying the taxable amount of ten cents (\$.10) per mile

21 by the large truck's weight rating as a percentage of

22 eighty thousand (80,000) pounds subtracted from one hundred

23 percent (100%) and then multiplied by two (2).

Τ	39-23-104. Wyoming large trucks; reporting; payment.
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3	(a) Large trucks registered in Wyoming as Wyoming
4	based commercial vehicles under W.S. 31-18-201, or
5	otherwise registered in Wyoming, shall report annually to
6	the department, on or before the date that the large truck
7	must be registered. The report shall contain the following
8	information and such other information as required by the
9	department:
10	
11	(i) The number of instate miles traveled during
12	the preceding registration year. Only those instate miles
13	traveled on public roadways in Wyoming shall be reported;
14	
15	(ii) A description and identification of the
16	large truck;
17	
18	(iii) A declaration of the large truck's gross
19	vehicle weight rating and gross combined weight rating.
20	
21	(b) Reporting shall be made on forms supplied by the
22	department.

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1 (c) At the time of submitting the report required by

2 subsection (a) of this section, the owner of the large

3 truck for which the report is submitted shall pay the tax

4 imposed by W.S. 39-23-103 based on the instate miles

5 reported.

6

7 39-23-105. Out-of-state large trucks; reporting;

8 payment.

9

10 (a) The department shall adopt rules which provide

11 for reporting and payment of the tax imposed by W.S.

12 39-24-103 by large trucks which are not registered in

13 Wyoming. The rules shall:

14

15 (i) Require that the same information be

16 reported as is required of large trucks registered in

17 Wyoming pursuant to W.S. 39-23-104;

18

19 (ii) Require the payment of the tax imposed by

20 W.S. 39-23-103 on instate miles traveled on public roadways

21 in Wyoming;

22

23 (iii) Require that reporting and payment be made

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24 to the department;

2 (iv) Require that payment be made at the time of 3 reporting;

4

5 (v) Require reporting and payment on a taxable

6 period which is not longer than one (1) year, but which may

7 be a shorter period of time and which may include reporting

8 and payment on a per-trip basis;

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10 (vi) Establish convenient locations at which

11 reporting and payment can be made which locations may

12 include ports of entry;

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14 (vii) Adopt other rules necessary or convenient

15 for the implementation of this section.

16

39-23-106. Department rules.

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19 (a) In addition to other rules required or allowed by

20 this act, the department shall adopt rules which shall:

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22 (i) Require the owners of large trucks to

23 accurately record the number of miles they travel on

24 Wyoming public roadways, including any ancillary

1 information regarding the routes or dates traveled and

2 other information deemed necessary by the department;

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4 (ii) Adopt compliance or audit procedures which

5 assure that large trucks using Wyoming's roadways are

6 paying the tax due under this act. The rules may authorize

7 the random inspection of records required by this act or by

8 department rules, but may not authorize any large truck to

9 be stopped for the sole purpose of inspecting required

10 records.

11

12 (b) In adopting rules pursuant to this act, the

13 department shall, to the maximum extent possible, adopt the

14 use of forms and procedures which are already used in

15 Wyoming for the purpose of proportional registration, the

16 international registration plan for apportioned commercial

17 vehicles or otherwise and which minimize any new burdens

18 imposed on the owners of large trucks.

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20 **39-23-107.** Distribution.

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22 All taxes collected under this act shall be distributed

23 pursuant to the distribution formula contained in W.S.

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24 39-17-211(d)(ii).

2 39-23-108. Report of revenues collected.

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- 4 On or before December 1 of each year, the department of
- 5 transportation shall report to the joint appropriations
- 6 interim committee and the joint transportation, highways
- 7 and military affairs interim committee the revenues
- 8 collected pursuant to this act.

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- 10 Section 2. This act shall apply to miles traveled by
- 11 large trucks beginning January 1, 2014. Payments of the
- 12 tax due under this act made after January 1, 2014 and
- 13 before January 1, 2015 shall be based on miles traveled
- 14 from January 1, 2014 until the date payment is due.

15

- 16 **Section 3.** The department of transportation shall
- 17 conduct a study of overweight vehicle fees imposed by
- 18 Wyoming law to determine if the fees being collected fully
- 19 compensate the state of Wyoming for wear or damage done to
- 20 Wyoming roads by vehicles which are not taxed by this act
- 21 because they exceed the weight limits to which this act
- 22 applies. The department shall report the results of its
- 23 study to the joint transportation, highways and military
- 24 affairs interim committee on or before October 1, 2013.

2 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

4 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

5 Constitution.
