## A BILL

## for

1	AN ACT relating to elections; providing for filing of
2	candidates' campaign reports by the candidates' designated
3	principal campaign committees; modifying penalty provisions
4	accordingly; and providing for an effective date.

6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 22-25-106(a)(i) through (iii), (b)(i)
9	and (c) and 22-25-108 by creating a new subsection (f) are
10	amended to read:
11	
12	22-25-106. Filing of campaign reports.
13	
14	(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (g) of
15	this section and in addition to other statements required
16	by this subsection:

2	(i) Every candidate shall file <mark>, or</mark>
3	alternatively, a candidate's designated principal campaign
4	committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii) shall file on behalf
5	of the candidate and the committee, a fully itemized
6	statement of receipts at least seven (7) days before any
7	primary, general or special election with information
8	required by this subsection current to any day from the
9	eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the election;
10	
11	(ii) Every candidate, whether successful or not,
12	shall file, or alternatively, a candidate's designated
13	principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii)
14	shall file on behalf of the candidate and the committee, a
15	fully itemized statement of receipts and expenditures
16	within ten (10) days after any general or special election;
17	
18	(iii) Every candidate in any primary election
19	shall file, or alternatively, a candidate's designated
20	principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii)
21	shall file on behalf of the candidate and the committee, a
22	fully itemized statement of receipts and expenditures
23	within ten (10) days after the primary election;

1 (b) Reports of itemized statements of receipt and 2 statements of receipts and expenditures, and statements of 3 termination shall be made with the appropriate filing 4 officers specified under W.S. 22-25-107 and in accordance 5 with the following:

(i) Except as otherwise provided 7 in this any political action committee, candidate's 8 section, 9 campaign committee not designated as a candidate's 10 principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii), or any political action committee formed under federal law 11 or the law of another state that contributes to a Wyoming 12 political action committee or to a candidate's campaign 13 any organization 14 committee, making an independent W.S. 22-25-102(k), 15 expenditure under and any other organization supporting or opposing any ballot proposition 16 17 which expends any funds in any primary, general or special election shall file an itemized statement of receipts at 18 least seven (7) days before the election current to any day 19 20 from the eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the 21 election and shall also file a statement of receipts and 22 expenditures within ten (10) days after a primary, general 23 or special election;

1	(c) All statements required by subsection (b) of this
2	section and those required by subsection (a) of this
3	section which are filed by a candidate's principal campaign
4	committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii), shall be signed by
5	both the chairman and treasurer. The statements shall set
6	forth the full and complete record of receipts including
7	cash, goods or services and except for statements of
8	receipts required under paragraph (i) of this subsection,
9	of actual and promised expenditures. The date of each
10	receipt of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or more, any
11	expenditure or obligation, the name of the person from whom
12	received or to whom paid and the purpose of each
13	expenditure or obligation shall be listed. Nothing in this
14	subsection shall be construed to require the disclosure of
15	the names of individuals paid to circulate an initiative or
16	referendum petition. All receipts under twenty-five dollars
17	(\$25.00) shall be reported but need not be itemized. Should
18	the accumulation of receipts from an individual exceed the
19	twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) threshold, all receipts from
20	that individual shall be itemized. If the receipts,
21	expenditures or obligations were for more than one (1)
22	candidate, the amounts attributable to each shall be
23	itemized separately.

1	22-25-108. Failure of candidate or committee to file
2	statement.
3	
4	(f) The penalties under this section for failure to
5	file a report shall apply to a candidate regardless of
6	whether the failure to file is the result of the candidate
7	not filing or the candidate's designated principal campaign
8	committee not filing.
9	
10	Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2014.
