8	Section 1. W.S. 30-6-102(b)(i), (e)(i) and (ii) is
9	amended to read:

11	30-6-102. Account created; expenditures; report.

13	(b) The board shall:

15	(i) Serve disabled or incapacitated miners in
16	this state with emphasis on pulmonary/respiratory, hearing

loss, cardiac and musculoskeletal and other conditions, of 1 2 miners as defined by rule and regulation of the board, due 3 to labor in the mining industry for expenses which are not 4 otherwise covered by public or private insurance or other 5 public health care program; 6 (e) As used in this section: 7 8 9 (i) "Coal or other Mine" means an area of land which minerals are extracted 10 from and processed in 11 nonliquid form or, if in liquid form, through an in situ leach process; 12 13 (ii) "Miner" means a resident of Wyoming who has 14 worked in a mine in this state or a contiguous state who is 15 or was employed full-time in a mining capacity at a coal or 16 17 other mine or at a processing or conversion facility contiguous to the mine and dependent upon the output of 18 that mine as feedstock. "Miner" shall include the operator 19 of the mine or plant if the operator works on a continuing 20 21 or irregular basis; and the mine is:

1	(A) Under the jurisdiction of the state
2	mine inspector or the mines safety health administration;

5	(B) An in situ leach process mine.

7	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
8	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
9	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
10	Constitution.
