1	AN ACT relating to the state board of education; creating a
2	director of the department of education appointed by the
3	state board; specifying duties; providing for the election
4	of members; modifying the appointment of members; providing
5	conforming amendments; prescribing the transition for the
6	department and director; and providing for an effective
7	date.
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9	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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11	Section 1. W.S. 21-1-105 is created to read:
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13	21-1-105. Director of department of education;
14	appointment.
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1 (a) The state board of education shall appoint a person as the director of the state 2 department of 3 education, who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor and may be removed by him as provided in W.S. 9-1-202 or 4 5 with a vote of no confidence by the state board. The director shall at minimum, hold a master's degree in 6 business, public or education administration, or other 7 advanced degree from an accredited 8 relevant hiqher 9 education institution, have a minimum of ten (10) years of 10 management or administrative experience in education, 11 government or business, provide credentials demonstrating exceptional accomplishment in previous employment, 12 and 13 provide evidence of problem solving skills, organizational 14 skills, education assessment and accountability experience and knowledge of statistical analysis, data management, 15 school finance and possess effective communication skills. 16 17 The director shall carry out the duties prescribed by W.S. 21-2-202 and other duties as may be prescribed by law. 18 The director's salary shall be determined by the governor. 19 The 20 appointment under this subsection shall be with the advice 21 and consent of the senate in accordance with W.S. 28-12-101 22 through 28-12-103, except the duties of the governor under those provisions shall be carried out by the state board. 23

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The director shall serve as the administrative 1 (b) head and chief executive officer of the state department of 2 3 education. 4 5 Section 2. W.S. 21-2-301, 22-2-105(a)(ii)(intro), 22-6-125(a) by creating a new paragraph (ix) 6 and by renumbering paragraphs (ix) through (xiv) as (x) through 7 (xv) and 22-6-126(b) are amended to read: 8 9 21-2-301. Appointment; gualifications, 10 terms and removal of members; meetings; chairman. 11 12 There is created a state board of education 13 (a) composed of twelve (12) ten (10) voting members, eleven 14 (11) four (4) of whom shall be appointed members. with at 15 least one (1) member appointed from each appointment 16 district pursuant to W.S. 9-1-218. The remaining voting 17 member of the board shall be the state superintendent of 18 public instruction. One (1) appointed member shall be 19 appointed at large and shall be a certified classroom 20 21 teacher at the time of appointment. One (1) appointed 22 member shall also be appointed at large and shall be a certified school administrator at the time of appointment. 23 24 Two (2) appointed members shall be appointed at large and

1 shall be representative of private business or industry in 2 Wyoming. The remaining seven (7) appointed members of the 3 board shall be appointed from among the lay citizens of the 4 state who are electors of the state, known for their public 5 spirit, business or professional ability and interest in education. Not more than six (6) appointed members of the 6 board shall be from one (1) political party. Members shall 7 be appointed for six (6) year terms, except those who may 8 9 be appointed to fill unexpired terms. Members shall be 10 appointed by the governor with the approval of the senate. 11 Vacancies shall be filled by the governor without senate approval until the next session of the legislature. 12 No 13 member is eligible to reappointment, except any member appointed to fill an unexpired term of less than six (6) 14 years and the term expires on or after January 1, 1996, may 15 be reappointed for one (1) additional six (6) year term. 16 17 Appointed members of the board may be removed by the qovernor as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. 18

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(b) The remaining six (6) voting members of the state
board shall be elected by nonpartisan ballot at each
general election for a term of four (4) years pursuant to
the provisions of this section and title 22 of the Wyoming
statutes. One (1) member shall be elected from among the

1 (b) (c) During the first quarter of the calendar year 2 3 a meeting shall be held at which a chairman shall be 4 elected. Meetings may be held at regular intervals as 5 often as the duties of the board require and the board shall meet at the call of the state superintendent of 6 public instruction or the governor or the chairman whenever 7 in the opinion of these officials, or any of them, the need 8 9 for such meeting exists. 10 (c) (d) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this 11 section, The superintendent of public instruction shall not 12 13 participate in board deliberations on or vote on any matter relating to a contested case involving actions of the 14 department of education. 15 16 22-2-105. Terms of office and offices voted on at 17 general elections. 18 19 The terms of office and offices voted on at 20 (a) 21 general elections are as follows: 22 (ii) Four Year Term. - At the general election 23

24 in 1974 and in every fourth (4th) year thereafter, there

shall be elected the following officers: one (1) governor, 1 one (1) secretary of state, one (1) state treasurer, one 2 3 (1) state auditor, one (1) superintendent of public 4 instruction, county clerks, county treasurers, county 5 assessors, county coroners, county and prosecuting attorneys, district attorneys, sheriffs, clerks of the 6 district court and members of the state school board. At 7 every general election there shall be elected the necessary 8 9 member or members of the Wyoming senate and county 10 commissioners. The question of retention of a circuit court judge or a magistrate of the circuit court shall be 11 submitted: 12 13

Form of nonpartisan ballots. 14 (b) The official nonpartisan ballot for a primary 15 election shall be so identified in the title and shall omit 16 17 all references to justices of the supreme court, judges of the district court, and circuit court judges and members of 18 the state school board but otherwise shall be in the same 19 form as the general election nonpartisan ballot. 20 21 Section 3. W.S. 21-1-104 and Sections 4(a) and 5(a) 22 enacted by Senate File by the 2013 Wyoming 23 as 104 24 legislature are repealed.

(a) The service of the seven (7) members appointed at 4 5 large to the state board to represent the lay citizens of the state who are electors of the state, known for their 6 spirit, business or professional ability and 7 public interest in education and who were not appointed to fulfill 8 9 the requirements for a certified classroom teacher, a 10 certified school administrator and two (2) representatives 11 of private business or industry in Wyoming as required by W.S. 21-2-301, shall terminate on January 5, 2015. 12

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The election of six (6) state board members as 14 (b) required by W.S. 21-2-301(a) as amended by this act, shall 15 commence with the 2014 general election by nonpartisan 16 The service of the members elected shall enter 17 ballot. upon their respective duties 18 on January 5, 2015. Notwithstanding W.S. 21-2-301(b), the initial term of the 19 20 elected state board members from board of education 21 election districts 1, 3 and 5 shall be for a term of two 22 (2) years.

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1 (C) The provisions of W.S. 21-2-301(a) as amended by this act, shall not be implemented in a manner to affect 2 3 the term of the state board members appointed at large that 4 represent a certified classroom teacher, a certified school 5 administrator and two (2) representatives of private business or industry in Wyoming prior to the effective date 6 of this act. Any member appointed prior to the effective 7 date of this act and serving on the effective date of this 8 9 may be reappointed if otherwise qualified act for 10 reappointment under W.S. 21-2-301(a).

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intention and direction of 14 (a) It is the the legislature that all divisions, agencies, programs, 15 positions, personnel, property, appropriated funds 16 and 17 functions of the department of education shall transfer immediately to the interim director of the department of 18 education as appointed by the state board of education as 19 required by this act. 20

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(b) The state board shall immediately appoint a person to serve as the interim director of the Wyoming department of education upon the effective date of this
