1	AN ACT relating to public employee benefits; providing for
2	participation in the law enforcement plan under the Wyoming
3	Retirement Act by a peace officer employed by the
4	department of state parks and cultural resources;
5	authorizing election by peace officers currently employed
6	by the department of state parks and cultural resources;
7	specifying implementation; and providing for an effective

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10	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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12	Section 1. W.S. 9-3-402(a)(xviii) is amended to read:
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14	9-3-402. Definitions.
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16	(a) As used in this article:

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2 "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" (xviii) 3 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county 4 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized 5 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), investigator 6 employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 7 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 8 9 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, probation and parole agent employed by the Wyoming department of 10 11 corrections, Wyoming law enforcement academy instructor, University of Wyoming campus police officer, peace officer 12 13 employed by the department of state parks and cultural officer or dispatcher for 14 resources, detention law enforcement agencies; 15

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Section 2. Coverage of a peace officer employed by 17 the department of state parks and cultural resources, as a 18 law enforcement member under W.S. 9-3-432 as provided by 19 20 section 1 of this act shall commence on July 1, 2013, 21 unless a peace officer employed by the department of state 22 parks and cultural resources, elects to continue 23 participation in the Wyoming Retirement Act as a general 24 member. The election shall be made by providing notice to

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1	the Wyoming retirement board not later than April 30, 2013.
2	Once an election is made it shall not be rescinded.
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4 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 7 Constitution.
