- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to change the
- 2 eligibility requirements for Social Security Disability
- 3 Insurance and Supplemental Security Income benefits for
- 4 individuals with a terminal illness.

- 6 WHEREAS, workers in our country pay into the Social
- 7 Security system. While primarily a program to help older
- 8 Americans in retirement, Social Security is also a
- 9 fundamental element of our country's safety net through
- 10 Social Security Disability Insurance. The federal
- 11 government also provides additional help through the
- 12 Supplementary Security Income program, which is paid for by
- 13 general revenues and is not tied to work history. These
- 14 programs are both administered by the Social Security
- 15 Administration; and

1 WHEREAS, Social Security Disability Insurance is aimed at

2 helping people who are unable to work due to severe,

3 permanent disabilities. Eligibility for this program

4 includes a five (5) month waiting period. There is no

5 waiting period to receive Supplementary Security Income

6 benefits, which provide additional support to low-income

7 people who are aged, blind or disabled; and

8

9 WHEREAS, people suffering from terminal illnesses who seek

10 benefits through Social Security Disability Insurance

11 currently are subject to the five (5) month waiting period.

12 This delay applies even when the person is not expected to

13 live that long. Since a person with such a diagnosis may

14 not immediately qualify under the Social Security Income

15 program, this presents a serious problem for these

16 individuals. To compound the suffering of these individuals

17 by delaying assistance is wrong. This problem could be

18 solved through the creation of a waiver of the five (5)

19 month delay for individuals diagnosed with a terminal

20 illness or through changes to the Social Security Income

21 program or both; and

23 WHEREAS, Social Security Disability Insurance and

24 Supplementary Security Income benefits are in place to

- 1 provide a modicum of assistance to those facing severe
- 2 hardships. Clearly, anyone diagnosed with a terminal
- 3 illness that includes a prognosis of only a few months to
- 4 live should be able to obtain this assistance. With proper
- 5 procedures for review and a requirement for a concurring
- 6 diagnosis, such a change to the eligibility requirements
- 7 should be implemented.

- 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 10 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

11

- 12 **Section 1.** Congress should change the eligibility
- 13 requirements for Social Security Disability Insurance and
- 14 Supplementary Security Income benefits for individuals who
- 15 have been diagnosed by a physician as terminally ill when
- 16 the diagnosis has been confirmed by another qualified
- 17 physician and includes an estimation that the illness will
- 18 result in death within six (6) months of the diagnosis.
