8 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-1-139 is created to read:

- 10 1-1-139. Responsibility of possessor of real property
- 11 for harm to trespasser.

- 13 (a) Except as provided in the Restatement (Second) of
- 14 Torts, Sections 334 through 339 (1965), a possessor of real
- 15 property including an owner, lessee, renter or other lawful
- 16 occupant is not liable to trespassers for physical harm
- 17 caused by his failure to exercise reasonable care:

2 (i) To put the land in a condition reasonably

3 safe for the trespasser; or

5 (ii) To carry on activities so as not to

endanger a trespasser. 6

(b) Nothing in this section shall be deemed to apply 8

9 to any injury to a trespasser through any intentional,

willful or wanton act. 10

This section shall not be deemed to create or 12

increase the liability of any possessor of real property 13

and shall not be deemed to affect any immunity from or 14

defense to liability established by any other section of 15

law, including the provisions of W.S. 34-19-101 through 16

34-19-107 or any immunity or defense available at common 17

law. 18

20 (d) As used in this section, "trespasser" means a

21 person who enters or remains on land in the possession of

22 another without valid privilege or consent created by the

2

possessor or otherwise. 23
