1 AN ACT relating to compulsory school attendance; modifying
2 compulsory school attendance requirements as specified; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-4-102(a)(intro) is amended to
8 read:

10 **21-4-102. When attendance required; exemptions;**
11 **withdrawal.**

13 (a) Every parent, guardian or other person having
14 control or charge of any child who is a resident of this
15 state and whose seventh birthday falls on or before
16 September 15 of any year and who has not yet attained his

1 ~~sixteenth~~eighteenth birthday or completed ~~the tenth~~ grade
2 twelve (12) shall be required to send ~~such~~the child to,
3 and ~~such~~the child shall be required to attend, a public or
4 private school each year, during the entire time that the
5 public schools ~~shall be~~are in session in the district in
6 which the pupil resides.; ~~provided, that~~ The board of
7 trustees of each school district may exempt any child from
8 the operation of this article when:
