Child abuse or neglect; persons required to 10 11 report. 12 (a) Any person who knows or has reasonable cause to 13 believe or suspect that a child has been abused or 14 neglected or who observes any child being subjected to 15 conditions or circumstances that would reasonably result in 16 abuse or neglect, shall immediately report it to the child 17

2	a report to be made. Any person who knowingly fails to
3	make a report required by this subsection is guilty of a
4	misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than
5	one (1) year, a fine of not more than one thousand dollars
6	(\$1,000.00), or both.

(d) Any person who knowingly and intentionally makes 8 9 a false report of child abuse or neglect, or who encourages or coerces another person to make a false report of child 10 abuse or neglect, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by 11 imprisonment for not more than six (6) months one (1) year, 12 a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars 13 (\$750.00) one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both. 14 15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2013. 16
