A Wyoming veterans' commission is created within 4 5 the military department consisting of twelve (12) members, not less than one (1) of whom shall reside in each judicial 6 district identified in W.S. 5-3-101, appointed by the 7 staggered terms of three 8 governor for (3) 9 Commencing with initial appointments made in 2005, four (4) 10 members of the board shall be appointed for a term of one 11 (1) year, four (4) members for a term of two (2) years and four (4) members for a term of three (3) years. 12 13 thereafter shall be three (3) years and staggered with one-14 third (1/3) of the members' terms expiring each year. Appointments shall be made without regard to political 15 affiliation, sex, sexual orientation or gender identity, 16 17 religion or ethnic background.
