| 15 | submitted to the resident electors within the proposed      |
| 16 | district at the first general election held two (2) years   |

| 2  | general election thereafter, until defeated the levy shall  |
| 3  | remain in effect until a petition to discontinue the tax,   |
| 4  | signed by not less than ten percent (10%) of the voters of  |

| 7  | approved by the voters. The proposal to discontinue the     |
