A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to special districts; specifying the  
2 procedure for continuing the senior citizen service  
3 district mill levy; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-15-102(d) is amended to read:

9 **18-15-102. Formation of district; mill levy.**

11 (d) If the proposition to authorize a mill levy is  
12 approved by the qualified electors of the proposed  
13 district, ~~the proposition to impose a levy in the same or~~  
14 ~~at a different amount not to exceed two (2) mills, shall be~~  
15 ~~submitted to the resident electors within the proposed~~  
16 ~~district at the first general election held two (2) years~~

1 ~~after the election authorizing the district and at each~~  
2 ~~general election thereafter, until defeated~~ the levy shall  
3 remain in effect until a petition to discontinue the tax,  
4 signed by not less than ten percent (10%) of the voters of  
5 the district, is received by the board of county  
6 commissioners, and the proposal to discontinue the tax is  
7 approved by the voters. The proposal to discontinue the  
8 tax shall be submitted to the voters of the district at the  
9 expense of the county at the next general election or by  
10 mail ballot pursuant to W.S. 22-29-115 and 22-29-116 for  
11 approval or disapproval. If the proposition to impose or  
12 ~~continue~~ discontinue a mill levy is defeated, the  
13 proposition shall not be submitted to the electors for a  
14 period of not less than one (1) year.

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
