A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution to require courts in this state to rely on
3 federal and state laws when deciding cases and to forbid
4 courts from using international law as precedent when
5 deciding cases.

7 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
9 separately, concurring therein:

11 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
12 Constitution, Article 5, Section 1 is proposed for
13 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
14 next general election for approval or rejection to become
15 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
16 majority of the electors at the election:

Article 5, Section 1. How judicial power vested.

(a) The judicial power of the state shall be vested in the senate, sitting as a court of impeachment, in a supreme court, district courts, and such subordinate courts as the legislature may, by general law, establish and ordain from time to time.
