1 classify an individual as an employee, or knowingly fail to disclose a material fact with the intention of preventing 2 3 or reducing the payment of benefits to any entitled 4 individual, to avoid being subject to this act or to avoid 5 or reduce any contribution or other payment required from an employing unit under this act, or willfully fail or 6 refuse to make any contribution or other payment. Any such 7 individual violating this subsection is guilty of a 8 9 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, a fine of not more than seven hundred 10 fifty dollars (\$750.00), or both. Each false statement, 11 misrepresentation, failure to properly classify an 12 13 individual as an employee or failure to disclose a material 14 fact is a separate offense.
