1 AN ACT relating to vehicle titling; removing titling requirements for specified trailers; and providing for an 2 effective date. 3 4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 5 6 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-101(b), 31-2-102(a) by creating 8 new paragraph (vii), 31-2-103(a)(vi), 31-2-104(a), a (h)(ii) and by creating new paragraph (iii) and 31-2-225(c) 9 by creating new paragraph (ii) are amended to read: 10 11 12 31-2-101. Required application. 13 Every owner or transferee upon transfer 14 (b) of ownership of any vehicle that has an identifying number 15 16 pursuant to W.S. 31-1-101(a)(ix), including off-road

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1 recreational or multipurpose vehicles and, for the purpose of titling under this section, including snowmobiles and 2 3 watercraft, but excluding utility trailers weighing one 4 thousand (1,000) pounds or less unladen, shall apply for a 5 certificate of title at the office of a county clerk. 6 7 31-2-102. Exemptions. 8 9 (a) No certificate of title shall be issued for: 10 (vii) Utility trailers weighing one thousand 11 (1,000) pounds or less unladen. 12 13 31-2-103. Contents of application; signature; vehicle 14 identification number; issuance of certificate. 15 16 17 (a) Applications for paper certificates of title or electronic certificates of title, if available, shall be 18 under oath and contain or be accompanied by: 19 20 21 (vi) In the case of a vehicle registered or 22 titled in a state other than Wyoming, or any nonexempt homemade vehicle, rebuilt vehicle, reconstructed vehicle, 23 any vehicle assembled from a kit or any vehicle for which a 24

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1 bond is required, a current statement made by a Wyoming law 2 enforcement officer, or licensed Wyoming dealer only for 3 vehicles in his inventory or possession, that the vehicle 4 identification number on the vehicle has been inspected and 5 that the inspection occurred in Wyoming and certifying the correct vehicle identification number displayed on 6 the licensed Wyoming dealer performing 7 vehicle. Any an inspection of a vehicle identification number under this 8 9 section shall, in addition to the requirements of this act, 10 do so pursuant to W.S. 31-11-108. In the case of a vehicle 11 not in Wyoming, the vehicle identification number may be inspected and certified on a form 12 approved by the 13 department if the inspection is made by an authorized law enforcement officer of a city, county or state 14 law enforcement agency or a commissioned officer at a federal 15 military installation or any other person authorized to do 16 17 so by law and delivered to the county clerk in the county where the application for certificate of title is made 18 along with payment for the inspection fee required under 19 W.S. 31-3-102(b)(iv); 20 21

22 **31-2-104.** Transfer of ownership.

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1 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the owner of a vehicle who sells or transfers his interest in a 2 vehicle for which a certificate of title is required and 3 has been issued shall endorse an assignment and warranty of 4 5 title upon the certificate for the vehicle with a statement of all liens and encumbrances thereon, which assignment, 6 warranty and statement shall be subscribed by the owner 7 before a notarial officer and acknowledged thereby in the 8 9 manner provided by law, to be dated and delivered to the 10 transferee at the time of delivering the vehicle. Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the transferee 11 shall present the certificate to a county clerk and apply 12 13 for a new certificate of title within the same time periods 14 as required by W.S. 31-2-201(a)(ii).

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(h) The requirement under subsection (a) of this section to deliver a certificate of title to a transferee at the time the vehicle is delivered does not apply to a transferor if:

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(ii) The transferor is an auctioneer of vehicles
and transfers the vehicle in the course of his business as
an auctioneer of vehicles or through an auctioneer of
vehicles. The transferor or auctioneer shall then deliver

the certificate of title to the transferee within thirty 1 2 (30) days of the date of sale and shall deliver to the 3 transferee at the time the vehicle is delivered a signed, 4 notarized bill of sale in substantially the following form: 5 VEHICLE BILL OF SALE 6 I, (NAME OF TRANSFEROR OR AUCTIONEER), on (date), 7 hereby sell and convey all (my interest the interest of 8 9 (name of current owner)) in the following described vehicle: (COLOR, YEAR, MAKE, MODEL, VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION 10 NUMBER) to (NAME OF TRANSFEREE) in exchange for: (sales 11 price). I hereby state that the certificate of title for 12 13 the above described vehicle is held by (NAME OF TRANSFEROR-VEHICLE AUCTIONEER, BANK OR OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITUTION) 14 and that within thirty (30) days, (NAME OF TRANSFEREE) will 15 be provided a properly executed title free of all liens for 16

the vehicle unless otherwise specified in this bill of

8	the registration of a vehicle unless a certificate of title
9	has been issued to the owner or the owner presents
10	satisfactory evidence that a certificate of title for the
11	vehicle has been previously issued to the owner by any
12	county clerk except:

14	(ii) A county treasurer may register a vehicle
15	without the vehicle's title if no title is required for the
16	vehicle and the owner, lessee or operator submits an
17	affidavit of ownership on a form prescribed by the
18	department which form is signed and sworn before a person
19	authorized to administer oaths and affirmations.
