1 AN ACT relating to mining and mineral contracts; amending
2 definition to include contracts for professional services;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 30-1-132 is amended to read:

9 **30-1-132. Provisions for indemnity in certain**
10 **contracts; definition.**

12 The term "agreement pertaining to any well for oil, gas, or
13 water, or mine for any mineral" as used in W.S. 30-1-131,
14 means any agreement or understanding, written or oral,
15 concerning any operations related to drilling, deepening,
16 reworking, repairing, improving, testing, treating,

1 perforating, acidizing, logging, conditioning, altering,
2 plugging, or otherwise rendering services, including
3 professional services, in or in connection with any well
4 drilled for the purpose of producing or disposing of oil,
5 gas or other minerals, or water, and designing, excavating,
6 constructing, improving, or otherwise rendering services in
7 or in connection with any mine shaft, drift, or other
8 structure intended for use in the exploration for or
9 production of any mineral, or an agreement to perform any
10 portion of any such work or services or any act collateral
11 thereto, including the furnishing or rental of equipment,
12 incidental transportation, and other goods and services
13 furnished in connection with any such service or operation.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2014.
