Not later than July 31, 2007, and not later than 1 (a) July 31 of each subsequent year thereafter, the chief 2 3 fiscal officer of the game and fish department shall prepare and certify a report of licenses sold or issued in 4 5 the previous calendar year under the following statutes: 6 (iv) W.S. 23-1-705(a), (d), and (e) and (h); and 7 8 23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope 9 hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt 10 licenses; gratuitous licenses. 11 12 13 (h) In addition the commission may, upon receipt of payment of antelope license fees, issue up to a total of 14 fifty (50) antelope licenses each year for the exclusive 15 distribution by nonprofit organizations dedicated to 16 17 providing hunting opportunities to individuals with disabilities for use by those individuals for hunting 18 Fifteen (15) of these complimentary 19 opportunities. 20 licenses shall be reserved for hunters who are either blind 21 or wheelchair bound.
