AN ACT relating to tourism; authorizing the Wyoming awards 1 card program; authorizing agreements between the department 2 3 of state parks and cultural resources and participating merchants; creating an account; providing for a continuous 4 appropriation; providing for rulemaking; providing 5 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 36-4-124 is created to read: 10 11 36-4-124. Wyoming awards card program; creation; 12

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(a) There is created the Wyoming awards card program 1 2 to encourage tourism in Wyoming. The program shall be 3 administered by the department. The department shall 4 develop a program consisting of the following elements: 5 6 (i) Participating merchants into may enter agreements with the department offering discounts and 7 promotions to persons purchasing a Wyoming awards card 8 9 issued by the board; 10 11 (ii) The department shall sell the Wyoming awards card through its website and may sell the Wyoming 12 13 awards card through any other selling agents; 14 15 (iii) The department shall coordinate with the 16 Wyoming game and fish department and the department of 17 tourism to market and promote the program; 18 (iv) The department shall establish through rule 19 20 regulation a price for the Wyoming awards card, and 21 requirements for selling agents and requirements for 22 participating merchants offering discounts and promotions through the program. 23

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1 (b) There is created the Wyoming awards card program 2 Funds in account. the account are continuously 3 appropriated as follows: 4 5 (i) Ten percent (10%) annually shall be credited to the department to be used for costs associated with 6 creating and marketing the Wyoming awards card program; and 7 8 9 (ii) Forty-five percent (45%) annually shall be credited to the game and fish fund created under W.S. 10 11 23-1-501; and 12 13 (iii) Forty-five percent (45%) annually shall be credited to the capital construction account created under 14 W.S. 36-4-121(h). 15 16 Section 2. W.S. 36-4-104 by creating a new subsection 17 (q) is amended to read: 18 19 department, in consultation with 20 (g) The the 21 commission, shall be responsible for implementing the 22 Wyoming award cards program developed under W.S. 36-4-124. 23

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Section 3. There is appropriated fifty thousand 1 2 dollars (\$50,000.00) from the general fund to the 3 department. This appropriation shall be for the period 4 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending 5 June 30, 2016. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of establishing the Wyoming awards card 6 program created by this act. Notwithstanding any other 7 provision of law, this appropriation shall not 8 be 9 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 10 from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 11 This appropriation shall not be included in the 12 2016. department's 2017-2018 standard biennial budget request. 13 14 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2014. 15 16
