2 specifying the boundaries of the reservation; requiring
3 state maps to show boundaries as specified; and providing
4 for an effective date.

14 **36-13-101. Wind River Indian Reservation boundaries.**

15

16 The boundaries of the Wind River Indian Reservation shall
17 not be recognized for any purpose as the boundaries

1 established in 1868 by the treaty between the United States
2 and the Eastern Shoshone and Bannock Tribes, 15 Stat. 673
3 (July 3, 1868). The boundaries of the Wind River Indian
4 Reservation shall be recognized by the state of Wyoming for
5 all purposes as the boundaries as established by the treaty
6 between the United States and the Eastern Shoshone and
7 Bannock Tribes, 15 Stat. 673 (July 3, 1868), and
8 subsequently diminished by the Act of 1905, 58 P.L. 185, 58
9 Cong. Ch. 1452, 33 Stat. 1016 (1905), and as subsequently
10 restored by 5 Fed. Reg. 1805 (May 17, 1940), 7 Fed. Reg.
11 7458 (Sept. 22, 1942), as corrected by 7 Fed. Reg. 9439
12 (Nov. 17, 1942), 7 Fed. Reg. 11100 (Dec. 30, 1942), 8 Fed.
13 Reg. 6857 (May 25, 1943), 9 Fed. Reg. 9749 (Aug. 10, 1944),
14 as amended by 10 Fed. Reg. 2812, 10 Fed. Reg. 2254 (Feb.
15 27, 1945), 10 Fed. Reg. 7542 (June 22, 1945), 13 Fed. Reg.
16 8818 (Dec. 30, 1948), 39 Fed. Reg. 27561 (July 30, 1974) as
17 amended by 40 Fed. Reg. 42553 (Sept. 15, 1975) and 40 Fed.
18 Reg. 43732 (Sept. 23, 1975).

23 All official maps produced or published by a state agency
24 which indicate the boundaries of the Wind River Indian

1 Reservation shall show the boundaries as defined in W.S.
2 36-13-101.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
