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13 21-2-304. Duties of the state board of education.

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15 (a) The state board of education shall:

1 (iii) By rule and regulation and in consultation 2 and coordination with local school districts, prescribe 3 uniform student content and performance standards for the 4 common core of knowledge and the common core of skills 5 specified under W.S. 21-9-101(b), and promulgate uniform standards for programs addressing the special needs of 6 student populations specified under W.S. 21-9-101(c) that 7 these student populations are 8 ensure provided the 9 opportunity to learn the common core knowledge and skills 10 prescribed by the uniform student content 11 performance standards pursuant to this paragraph. Student content and performance standards prescribed under this 12 13 paragraph shall include standards for graduation from any high school within any school district of this state and 14 shall describe required performance levels in order to 15 achieve proficiency of the common core of knowledge and 16 17 common core of skills prescribed under W.S. 21-9-101(b). The ability to prescribe content and performance standards 18 shall not be construed to give the state board of education 19 20 the authority to prescribe textbooks or curriculum which 21 the state board is hereby forbidden to do, nor shall the 22 state board have the authority to commit the state to federal oversight and regulation. Graduation standards 23 imposed under this paragraph shall require the successful 24

2 passing grades or by the successful performance on

3 competency-based equivalency examinations:

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5 21-9-101. Educational programs for schools;

6 standards; core of knowledge and skills; special needs

7 programs; class size requirements; cocurricular activities.

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9 (a) The board of trustees of each school district

10 within the state shall cause the schools under its

11 jurisdiction to provide an educational program in

12 accordance with uniform standards defined under this

13 section and rules and regulations promulgated by the state

14 board of education pursuant to W.S. 21-2-304(a). The

15 development and implementation of the uniform standards is

16 the responsibility of the state board in consultation with

17 school districts, and shall not require approval by or

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18 oversight of the federal government.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
