## A BILL

## For

AN ACT relating to court security; creating a court 1 2 security assistance fund; specifying purposes of the fund; providing for grants for court security equipment and 3 facilities; providing guidelines 4 construction of and procedures grants; authorizing rulemaking; 5 for appropriating funds to the court security assistance fund 6 and authorizing expenditures from the fund; and providing 7 for effective dates. 8 9 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 11 12 Section 1. W.S. 5-11-102 through 5-11-104 are created 13 to read:

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15 **5-11-102.** Definitions.

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(a) As used in this article, unless the context 1 2 requires otherwise: 3 (i) "Commission" means 4 the Wyoming court 5 security commission; 6 (ii) "Fund" means the court security assistance 7 fund created in W.S. 5-11-103; 8 9 (iii) "Local security team" means local court 10 11 security management committees established pursuant to security standards adopted by the commission. 12 13 5-11-103. Court security assistance fund; creation; 14 15 grant procedures. 16 There is created the court security assistance 17 (a) fund. Interest accruing to the fund shall be retained in 18 the fund. No monies shall be expended from the fund except 19 20 upon legislative appropriation. Notwithstanding W.S. 21 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) or 9-4-207, monies within the fund 22 shall not lapse or revert until directed by the legislature. 23

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1 (b) The supreme court may expend only monies 2 legislatively appropriated from the fund specifically for 3 administrative costs of the commission incurred in the 4 implementation of this article in any biennial period. All 5 other monies appropriated from the fund shall be available for grants to counties for the purposes specified in this 6 7 article.

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9 (c) Monies from the fund that are distributed to 10 counties pursuant to this article shall be used to 11 supplement existing county funding for purposes related to 12 security of facilities containing a state court and shall 13 not be used to supplant monies previously allocated by the 14 county for such purposes.

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16 (d) The commission shall adopt rules prescribing:17

18 (i) The procedures to be followed in making,
19 evaluating, prioritizing and recommending grant
20 applications;

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(ii) The criteria for evaluation, prioritization
and making recommendations for the grant of awards; and

Grant applications; requirements; 5 prioritization; recommendation; prohibited uses. 6 (a) To be eligible for a grant from the fund, a board 7 of county commissioners for a county in which a state court 8 9 is located shall apply to the commission based upon 10 recommendations of a local security team in accordance with 11 the timelines and other procedures adopted by rule of the commission. The grant application shall be signed by the 12 13 chairman of the county commission. 14 (b) Grants shall be used to fund counties that meet 15 the criteria specified in subsection (e) of this section 16 17 for the purchase of security equipment within courthouses or construction or modification of facilities containing a 18 19 state court. 20 21 (C) No grant funds shall be used for acquisition of 22 land or for infrastructure not within the property boundaries of the project. 23 24

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(d) Each grant shall require a matching amount from 1 2 the county not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of the 3 proposed project costs. 4 5 (e) Counties that meet at least two (2) of paragraphs (i) through (vi) of this subsection shall be given highest 6 priority for grants pursuant to this article: 7 8 9 (i) Counties in which: 10 11 (A) The total population is below the state median, as determined by the last federal census; 12 13 14 (B) The per capita income is below the state median, as determined by the most recent data 15 published by the division of economic analysis; 16 17 Property tax revenues are below the 18 (C) 19 state median, as determined by the most recent data published by the department of revenue; or 20 21 total county population 22 (D) The living below the federal poverty level is greater than the state 23 median, as determined by the last federal census. 24

1 2 (ii) Counties in which there have occurred 3 recent and serious security breaches or issues which cannot 4 adequately addressed by available county funds or be 5 resources; 6 (iii) Counties which impose all available mills 7 authorized by article 15, section 5 of the Wyoming 8 9 constitution; 10 (iv) Counties in which the local security team 11 has adopted a complete operational plan for court security 12 13 in accordance with commission standards; 14 (v) Counties which demonstrate a previous 15 financial commitment to court security initiatives; 16 17 (vi) Counties which have a need for facilities 18 for additional judicial resources as determined by the 19 supreme court's weighted caseload studies. 20 21 22 (f) The commission shall prioritize proposed grants it recommends for funding in accordance with this section 23 and commission rules. The commission shall forward all 24

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applications received and submit the prioritized list to
 the state loan and investment board for final approval or
 disapproval in accordance with rules of the board.

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5 (g) The state loan and investment board shall consider 6 all grants recommended by the commission and, applying its 7 own discretion and its own criteria developed pursuant to 8 this article and the priorities specified in this article, 9 approve, modify or disapprove entirely the grant. Approved 10 grant funds shall be distributed from the court security 11 assistance fund.

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(h) The state loan and investment board shall adopt rules as necessary or convenient to implement its duties and for distribution of funds by the office of state lands and investments under this article.

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18 Section 2. W.S. 5-11-101(e)(iii) and by creating a 19 new paragraph (v) is amended to read:

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Notwithstanding any other provision of 1 law, this 2 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose. This appropriation shall not be included in 3 4 the supreme court's 2017-2018 standard biennial budget 5 request. 6 Section 4. 7 8 (a) Section 1 of this act is effective immediately 9 upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become 10 law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 11 Constitution. 12 13 (b) The remainder of this act is effective July 1, 14 15 2014. 16 17 (END)
