- 15 (a) Each district which meets the following
- 16 requirements is eligible to share in the distribution of
- 17 funds from the foundation account:

2	(v) Provision of professional development and
3	training programs for district teachers and principals
4	outside of and between regular school year sessions, as
5	annually certified to the director by the district
6	superintendent. On-site coaching and mentoring by district
7	instructional facilitators pursuant to W.S. 21-13-335 and
8	on-going periodic collaborative planning and job-embedded
9	or preparation sessions for improvement in curriculum and
LO	instruction are not subject to this paragraph. Nothing in
L1	this paragraph prevents professional development and
L2	training programs subject to this paragraph from being
L3	provided during regular school year sessions if schools are
L4	not in session for reasons other than for teacher and
L5	principal attendance at professional development and
L6	training programs. The requirement of this paragraph may
L7	be waived by the director for any school district, for any
L8	school year, for good cause as demonstrated by evidence
L9	produced by the district superintendent prior to March 15
20	of the school year preceding the school year of application
21	of the waiver. This paragraph shall not apply to charter
22	schools established under W.S. 21-3-301 through 21-3-314.
