(vii) "Simulcasting" means the sale 1 of pari-mutuel pools electronically transmitted live 2 or 3 historic on interstate or intrastate pari-mutuel events as prescribed by the commission. The commission 4 5 authorize simulcasting subject to the following conditions: 6 (B) Simulcasting may be conducted only if 7 the holder of the permit provides the commission with a 8 9 fully executed copy of an agreement with the horsemen's association which includes provisions allocating the 10 percentage of the takeout required under W.S. 11-25-105 to 11 purses on live flat track races, simulcasts and historic 12 races run by the permittee; 13 14 (B)(C) Simulcasting may be conducted off 15 the permitted premises only if the board of county 16 17 commissioners of the county in which such simulcasting will be conducted grant grants its approval; 18 19 20 (C) (D) No simulcasting may be conducted 21 within one hundred (100) miles of any premises permitted under this act, except that the commission may waive the 22 one hundred (100) mile limitation if the simulcast permit 23 application includes written approval from the permittee 24
