A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; creating the
- 2 offense of trespassing to collect data as specified;
- 3 creating a presumption; providing penalties; and providing
- 4 for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-303 by creating new subsections
- 9 (d) and (e) is amended to read:

10

- 6-3-303. Criminal trespass; trespassing to collect
- 12 data; penalties.

13

- 14 (d) A person is guilty of trespassing to collect data
- 15 if, without authorization, he enters or remains on or in
- 16 the land or premises of another person and collects

- 1 geological, physical or biological data including, without
- 2 limitation, photographs, written observations,
- 3 electronically collected data and physical samples or
- 4 specimens. If the data collected by the person includes
- 5 global positioning system data, specific geographic
- 6 coordinates or legal description of the property, the
- 7 person shall be presumed to know that he is on the land or
- 8 premises of another person under this subsection.

- 10 (e) Trespassing to collect data under subsection (d)
- 11 of this section is:

12

- 13 (i) A high misdemeanor for a first offense,
- 14 punishable by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year,
- a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)
- 16 or both. When imposing a sentence under this section, the
- 17 court shall take into consideration evidence by the person
- 18 or entity that collected the data that any data collected
- 19 has been expunged from all records and databases;

- 21 (ii) A felony for a second or subsequent
- 22 offense, punishable by imprisonment for not more than five
- 23 (5) years, a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars
- 24 (\$10,000.00) or both. When imposing a sentence under this

1 section, the court shall take into consideration evidence

2 by the person or entity that collected the data that any

3 data collected has been expunged from all records and

4 databases.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

9 Constitution.
