AN ACT relating to natural gas; creating the task force for 1 the expansion of natural gas service to rural 2 and underserved cities and towns; requiring a report; providing 3 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. 8 9 (a) There is created a task force for the expansion 10 of natural gas service to rural and underserved cities and 11 towns consisting of the following members: 12 13 (i) One (1) member of the Wyoming senate, 14 appointed by the president of the senate who shall be a 15

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joint minerals, business 1 member of the and economic 2 development interim committee; 3 4 (ii) One (1) member of the Wyoming house of 5 representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house, who shall be a member of the joint minerals, business and 6 7 economic development interim committee; 8 9 (iii) Two (2) members appointed by the governor. One (1) of the members shall represent natural gas utility 10 providers and one (1) shall be a member of the governor's 11 12 office; 13 (iv) One (1) member designated by the Wyoming 14 association of municipalities; 15 16 Wyoming 17 (v) One (1) member representing the county commissioners association; 18 19 20 (vi) One (1) member of the Wyoming public 21 service commission. 22

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force 1 (b) The task shall be staffed by the 2 legislative service office. State agencies shall provide 3 information and assistance to the task force as requested. 4 5 (c) The task force shall: 6 (i) Evaluate the number of cities, towns and 7 rural residential areas which do not have access to natural 8 9 qas service; 10 11 (ii) Review the legal and logistical issues associated with expanding natural gas service to those 12 13 underserved areas; 14 15 (iii) Develop preliminary estimates on the costs and infrastructure necessary to provide natural gas service 16 17 to those underserved areas; 18 (iv) Evaluate potential programs that could be 19 20 implemented through the state or its agencies to expand 21 natural gas service to those areas. 22 The task force shall submit its recommendations, 23 (d) including any proposed legislation with respect to the 24

issues specified in subsection (c) of this section, to the 1 2 joint minerals, business and economic development interim committee and the governor no later than November 1, 2014. 3 4 The joint minerals, business and economic development 5 interim committee shall consider the recommendations and develop legislation it deems appropriate for consideration 6 by the legislature in the 2015 general session. 7

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9 (e) The task force shall exist until December 31, Members of the task force who are not state 10 2014. 11 employees or legislators shall not receive a salary but shall receive reimbursement for mileage and per diem 12 13 expenses at the rate provided for legislators under W.S. 28-5-101. Members of the task force who are legislators 14 shall be paid salary, per diem and mileage as provided in 15 W.S. 28-5-101 for their official duties as members of the 16 task force. 17

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19 There is appropriated from the general fund: (f)

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21 (i) Four thousand five hundred dollars 22 (\$4,500.00) to the legislative service office for payment of salary, per diem and mileage for legislative task force 23 24 members;

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1 2 (ii) Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to the governor's office for payment of authorized per diem and 3 4 mileage for nonlegislative task force members. 5 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 6 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 8 Constitution. 9 10 (END) 11

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
