

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0031

Game and fish-fees.

Sponsored by: Joint Travel, Recreation, Wildlife and  
Cultural Resources Interim Committee

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; amending hunting,  
2 fishing, watercraft and other license and application fees  
3 as specified; requiring reports; authorizing rulemaking;  
4 and providing for an effective date.

5

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8       **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-702, 23-2-101(d), (e), (f) (i)  
9 through (iii), (j) (i) through (x), (xii) through (xv),  
10 (xviii), (xix), (xxii) through (xxxi), (xxxiv), (xxxv),  
11 (xxxvii) through (xlii), (xliii) (A), (B) and (k),  
12 23-2-107(c) (ii) and (e), 23-2-201(d) (i), (ii) and (vi)  
13 through (viii), 23-2-301(c) (i) through (xii),  
14 23-2-306(a) (intro) and (b) (intro), 23-2-307(b),  
15 41-13-104(f) and 41-13-109(a) (i) and (ii) are amended to  
16 read:

1

2           **23-1-702. Duplicate license upon loss or destruction**  
3 **of original; issuance; fees.**

4

5 When any license issued under this act has been lost or  
6 destroyed, the licensee may secure a duplicate of the  
7 original license from any district office or any authorized  
8 personnel of the department upon the presentation of  
9 satisfactory proof that the original license was lost or  
10 destroyed. Prior to issuing the duplicate license and in  
11 accordance with rule and regulation of the commission, the  
12 department may assess a fee of not more than ~~three dollars~~  
13 ~~(\$3.00)~~ three dollars and thirty cents (\$3.30), plus the  
14 fee charged under W.S. 23-1-701. Duplicate licenses shall  
15 be issued in accordance with procedure established by  
16 commission order.

17

18           **23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application**  
19 **fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency**  
20 **required.**

21

22           (d) The commission may issue big or trophy game  
23 licenses in areas in which all licenses initially  
24 authorized were not purchased or in which additional

1 harvest is desired, allowing a licensee to take a big or  
2 trophy game animal of such sex or age as designated by the  
3 commission. The fee for the license may be reduced by the  
4 commission to the level necessary to achieve the desired  
5 management objectives, but in no case shall a ~~resident or~~  
6 ~~nonresident~~ license fee, excluding resident and nonresident  
7 youth license fees, be less than the landowner's coupon  
8 fee.

9  
10 (e) Resident and nonresident license applicants shall  
11 pay an application fee in an amount specified by this  
12 subsection upon submission of an application for purchase  
13 of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license  
14 or wild bison license. The resident application fee shall  
15 be ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ six dollars (\$6.00) and the  
16 nonresident application fee shall be ~~fourteen dollars~~  
17 ~~(\$14.00)~~ fifteen dollars and fifty cents (\$15.50). The  
18 application fee is in addition to the fees prescribed by  
19 subsections (f) and (j) of this section and by W.S.  
20 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the department either  
21 directly or through an authorized selling agent of the  
22 department. At the beginning of each month, the commission  
23 shall set aside all of the fees collected during calendar  
24 year 1980 and not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of

1 the fees collected thereafter pursuant to this subsection  
2 to establish and maintain a working balance of five hundred  
3 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), to compensate owners or  
4 lessees of property damaged by game animals and game birds.

5  
6 (f) Forty percent (40%) of available nonresident elk  
7 licenses, forty percent (40%) of available nonresident deer  
8 licenses and forty percent (40%) of available nonresident  
9 antelope licenses for any one (1) calendar year shall as  
10 established by the commission, be offered to nonresident  
11 applicants upon receipt of the fee prescribed by this  
12 subsection. Seventy-five (75) of the nonresident deer  
13 licenses set aside pursuant to this subsection shall be  
14 used for a national bow hunt for deer. The licenses  
15 authorized by this subsection shall be offered by drawing  
16 to nonresident applicants prior to the drawing for the  
17 remaining nonresident licenses issued. The licenses  
18 offered under this subsection shall be issued in a manner  
19 prescribed by rules and regulations promulgated by the  
20 commission. Nothing in this subsection shall prohibit any  
21 unsuccessful applicant for a nonresident license pursuant  
22 to this subsection from submitting an application for any  
23 licenses remaining after the drawing during the calendar  
24 year in which the application under this subsection was

1 submitted. The following fees shall be collected by the  
2 department and are in addition to the nonresident license  
3 fee for the appropriate big game species imposed under  
4 subsection (j) of this section and the application fee  
5 imposed under subsection (e) of this section:

6

7 (i) Nonresident elk license ..... ~~\$480.00~~  
8 \$530.00 in addition to the license fee imposed under  
9 paragraph (j)(xix) of this section;

10

11 (ii) Nonresident deer license .... ~~\$240.00~~  
12 \$264.00 in addition to the license fee imposed under  
13 paragraph (j)(xv) of this section;

14

15 (iii) Nonresident antelope license ..... ~~\$240.00~~  
16 \$264.00 in addition to the license fee imposed under  
17 paragraph (j)(xxxi) of this section.

18

19 (j) Subject to W.S. 23-2-101(f), 23-1-705(e) and the  
20 applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, the following hunting  
21 licenses and tags may be purchased for the fee indicated  
22 and subject to the limitations provided:

14 (k) Any resident qualified to purchase a moose or ram  
15 big horn sheep hunting license under subsection (b) of this  
16 section may pay a fee of ~~seven dollars (\$7.00)~~ eight  
17 dollars (\$8.00) in lieu of applying for a moose or ram big  
18 horn sheep hunting license. Payment of the fee for a  
19 particular species under this subsection shall authorize  
20 the person to accumulate points under W.S. 23-1-703(b) for  
21 that year in the same manner as if he had unsuccessfully  
22 applied for a hunting license for that species. Payment of  
23 the fee shall be made in compliance with application dates.

24

1           **23-2-107. Wild bison licenses.**

2

3           (c) The commission shall promulgate reasonable rules  
4 and regulations regulating wild bison licenses and the  
5 management of wild bison. The rules shall provide for:

6

7           (ii) A nonrefundable entry fee for the drawing  
8 of a license, which shall be a minimum of ~~six dollars~~  
9 ~~(\$6.00)~~ seven dollars (\$7.00);

10

11           (e) A resident applicant shall pay a license fee of  
12 ~~four hundred dollars (\$400.00)~~ four hundred forty dollars  
13 (\$440.00) for a license to harvest any wild bison or ~~two~~  
14 ~~hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)~~ two hundred seventy-five  
15 dollars (\$275.00) for a license to harvest a female or calf  
16 wild bison and shall pay the fee required by W.S.  
17 23-2-101(e). A nonresident applicant shall pay a license  
18 fee of ~~two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00)~~ two  
19 thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$2,750.00) for a  
20 license to harvest any wild bison or ~~one thousand dollars~~  
21 ~~(\$1,000.00)~~ one thousand one hundred dollars (\$1,100.00)  
22 for a license to harvest a female or calf wild bison and  
23 shall pay the fee required by W.S. 23-2-101(e). The fee

1 charged under W.S. 23-1-701 shall be in addition to the fee  
2 imposed under this subsection.

3

4 **23-2-201. Fees; restrictions; verification of**  
5 **residency required.**

6

7 (d) The following fishing licenses may be purchased  
8 for the fee indicated in addition to the applicable fee  
9 under W.S. 23-1-701 and subject to the limitations  
10 provided:

11

12 (i) Resident fishing license..... ~~\$22.00~~ \$24.00

14 (ii) Nonresident fishing license... ~~90.00~~ 100.00

23 **23-2-301. Miscellaneous fees; verification of**  
24 **residency required.**

2 (c) The following licenses and tags may be purchased  
 3 for the fee indicated in addition to the applicable fee  
 4 under W.S. 23-1-701 and subject to other requirements of  
 5 this article:

7 (i) Resident trapping license-furbearing

10 (ii) License to capture furbearing animals for  
 11 domestication..... ~~18.00~~ 20.00

13 (iii) Resident fur dealer's license ~~50.00~~ 55.00

13 **23-2-306. Conservation stamp; exemptions.**

14

15 (a) Subject to subsections (b) and (c) of this  
16 section and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, each  
17 sportsman licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or  
18 23-2-201 shall purchase a single conservation stamp for  
19 ~~twelve dollars (\$12.00)~~ thirteen dollars (\$13.00) which  
20 shall be valid for one (1) calendar year and the stamp or  
21 an authorization signifying purchase of the stamp shall be  
22 in the possession of any person exercising rights under any  
23 fishing or hunting license issued pursuant to W.S.  
24 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201. Holders of special limited

1 fishing permits issued under W.S. 23-2-207 and holders of  
2 licenses only under W.S. 23-2-101(j)(v) and (vi),  
3 23-2-201(d)(vi) and (vii), 23-2-201(f) and 23-2-201(g) are  
4 exempt from the provisions of this section when exercising  
5 hunting or fishing privileges provided under those specific  
6 licenses. Revenues collected from the sale of each stamp  
7 under this subsection shall be deposited as follows:

8

9 (b) A lifetime conservation stamp may be purchased  
10 for ~~one hundred eighty dollars (\$180.00)~~ two hundred  
11 dollars (\$200.00) plus the applicable fee under W.S.  
12 23-1-701. Revenues collected from the sale of each stamp  
13 under this subsection shall be deposited as follows:

14

15 **23-2-307. Special management permit.**

16

17 (b) Special management permits may be purchased from  
18 the department or its authorized selling agents for ~~twelve~~  
19 ~~dollars (\$12.00)~~ thirteen dollars (\$13.00) plus the  
20 applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701 and shall be valid for  
21 one (1) calendar year.

22

23 **41-13-104. Application for certificate; issuance of**  
24 **certificate and assignment of number; conformity with**

1 federal numbering system; expiration and renewal of  
2 certificate; transfer of ownership; duplicate certificate;  
3 manufacturer and dealer certificates.

4  
5 (f) Each certificate of number issued under this act  
6 expires on December 31 of the last year of valid  
7 registration under the certificate unless sooner terminated  
8 or discontinued under this act. A duplicate number may be  
9 obtained by an owner upon application to the department,  
10 which may require payment of a fee of not more than ~~five~~  
11 ~~dollars (\$5.00)~~ six dollars (\$6.00). Certificates of  
12 number may be renewed by the owner in the same manner  
13 provided under this act for obtaining initial  
14 certification.

15

16 **41-13-109. Motorboat registration fee.**

17

18 (a) The nonrefundable and nontransferable  
19 registration fee for motorboats is:

20

21 (i) ~~Fifteen dollars (\$15.00)~~ Seventeen dollars  
22 (\$17.00) for one (1) year; or

1                   (ii) ~~Forty dollars (\$40.00)~~ Forty-four dollars  
2 (\$44.00) for three (3) years.
