## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; amending hunting,
- 2 fishing, watercraft and other license and application fees
- 3 as specified; requiring reports; authorizing rulemaking;
- 4 and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

2 23-1-702. Duplicate license upon loss or destruction of original; issuance; fees. 3 4

5 When any license issued under this act has been lost or destroyed, the licensee may secure a duplicate of the 6 original license from any district office or any authorized 7 personnel of the department upon the presentation of 8 9 satisfactory proof that the original license was lost or 10 destroyed. Prior to issuing the duplicate license and in 11 accordance with rule and regulation of the commission, the department may assess a fee of not more than three dollars 12 13 (\$3.00) three dollars and thirty cents (\$3.30), plus the fee charged under W.S. 23-1-701. Duplicate licenses shall 14 be issued in accordance with procedure established by 15 commission order. 16

23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application 18 fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency 19 20 required.

22 (d) The commission may issue big or trophy game all 23 licenses in areas in which licenses 24 authorized were not purchased or in which additional

1 harvest is desired, allowing a licensee to take a big or

2 trophy game animal of such sex or age as designated by the

3 commission. The fee for the license may be reduced by the

4 commission to the level necessary to achieve the desired

5 management objectives, but in no case shall a resident or

6 nonresident license fee, excluding resident and nonresident

7 youth license fees, be less than the landowner's coupon

8 fee.

9

10 Resident and nonresident license applicants shall pay an application fee in an amount specified by this 11 subsection upon submission of an application for purchase 12 13 of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license or wild bison license. The resident application fee shall 14 be five dollars (\$5.00) six dollars (\$6.00) and the 15 nonresident application fee shall be fourteen dollars 16 17 (\$14.00) fifteen dollars and fifty cents (\$15.50). The application fee is in addition to the fees prescribed by 18 (f) and (j) of this section and by W.S. 19 subsections 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the department either 20 21 directly or through an authorized selling agent of the 22 department. At the beginning of each month, the commission shall set aside all of the fees collected during calendar 23 year 1980 and not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of 24

1 the fees collected thereafter pursuant to this subsection

2 to establish and maintain a working balance of five hundred

3 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), to compensate owners or

4 lessees of property damaged by game animals and game birds.

Forty percent (40%) of available nonresident elk 6 (f) licenses, forty percent (40%) of available nonresident deer 7 licenses and forty percent (40%) of available nonresident 8 9 antelope licenses for any one (1) calendar year shall as established by the commission, be offered to nonresident 10 11 applicants upon receipt of the fee prescribed by this Seventy-five (75) of the nonresident deer 12 subsection. 13 licenses set aside pursuant to this subsection shall be used for a national bow hunt for deer. The licenses 14 authorized by this subsection shall be offered by drawing 15 to nonresident applicants prior to the drawing for the 16 17 remaining nonresident licenses issued. The offered under this subsection shall be issued in a manner 18 prescribed by rules and regulations promulgated by the 19 20 commission. Nothing in this subsection shall prohibit any 21 unsuccessful applicant for a nonresident license pursuant 22 to this subsection from submitting an application for any licenses remaining after the drawing during the calendar 23 year in which the application under this subsection was 24
