1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act;
2 adding specified controlled substances to Schedule I and
3 Schedule II of the act; and providing for an effective

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1014(f)(intro) and by creating
9 new paragraphs (ix) through (xvi) and 35-7-1058(a)(vi) by
10 creating new subparagraphs (OO) through (QQ) and (vii) by
11 creating new subparagraphs (J) and (K) are amended to read:

15 (f) Stimulants. - Unless specifically excepted or
16 unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound,

1 mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of the
2 following substances having a stimulant effect on the
3 central nervous system, including its ~~salts,~~ optical,
4 positional, and geometric isomers, salts and salts of
5 isomers:
