Criminal trespass to collect data-amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; amending provisions
2 related to the crimes of trespassing to unlawfully collect
3 resource data and unlawful collection of resource data;
4 repealing the definition of "open land"; and providing for
5 an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-414(a)(i), (ii)(A), (B), (b),
10 (d)(i) and (iv)(intro) is amended to read:

11

12 **6-3-414. Trespassing to unlawfully collect resource**
13 **data; unlawful collection of resource data.**

14

1 (a) A person is guilty of trespassing to unlawfully
2 collect resource data if he:

3

4 (i) Enters onto ~~open~~private land for the
5 purpose of collecting resource data; and

6

7 (ii) Does not have:

8

9 (A) An ownership interest in the real
10 property or, statutory, contractual or other legal
11 authorization to enter ~~or access~~ the private land to
12 collect the specified resource data; or

13

14 (B) Written or verbal permission of the
15 owner, lessee or agent of the owner to enter ~~or access~~ the
16 private land to collect the specified resource data.

17

18 (b) A person is guilty of unlawfully collecting
19 resource data if he enters onto private ~~open~~ land and
20 collects resource data without:

21

22 (i) An ownership interest in the real property
23 or, statutory, contractual or other legal authorization to

1 enter the private land to collect the specified resource
2 data; or

3
4 (ii) Written or verbal permission of the owner,
5 lessee or agent of the owner to enter the private land to
6 collect the specified resource data.

7
8 (d) As used in this section:

9
10 (i) "Collect" means to take a sample of
11 material, acquire, gather, photograph or otherwise preserve
12 information in any form, ~~from open land which is submitted~~
13 ~~or intended to be submitted to any agency of the state or~~
14 ~~federal government~~ including the recording of a legal
15 description or geographical coordinates of the location of
16 the collection, from private land;

17
18 (iv) "Resource data" means data relating to
19 private land or private land use, including but not limited
20 to data regarding agriculture, minerals, geology, history,
21 cultural artifacts, archeology, air, water, soil,
22 conservation, habitat, vegetation or animal species.

23 "Resource data" does not include data:

1

2 **Section 2.** W.S. 6-3-414(d)(ii) is repealed.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
