- (i) Be subject to the competitive bid process as provided in W.S. 9-2-1016 (b) (iv) (A) through (C). Any contract may authorize the pari-mutuel permittee to conduct live and historic pari-mutuel events on the state fairgrounds;
- (ii) Provide that the amount remitted to the state fairgrounds construction and maintenance account shall be not less than the amount provided in W.S. 11-25-105(b)(iii) and may provide for additional amounts remitted to the account as the state fair board and permittee may agree upon.
- (d) The board shall periodically audit the records and practices of any permittee with whom the board contracts for pari-mutuel events at the state fairgrounds. Any permittee with a contract with the board shall provide the board a right of access to all records regarding revenues, profits, expenses and losses associated with pari-mutuel events held on the state fairgrounds.
