W.S. 21-15-105(b) is amended to read: 10 21-15-105. Bonded indebtedness mill levy supplement. 11 12 13 (b) This section only applies to bonds issued on or before February 23, 2001, the original term of which was 14

for at least ten (10) years. This section shall also apply 1 2 to the refunding of bonds issued on or before February 23, 2001, but only to those amounts of the refunding which 3 constitute original bonds issued on or before February 23, 4 2001. If a bond has been refunded, the term of the bonds 5 6 may be for a period less than or greater than ten (10) 7 years if the original term of the refunded bond was at least ten (10) years Effective commencing school year 8 2010-2011 and each school thereafter, this section shall 9 10 not apply to the refunding of any bond issues initially qualifying under this section and the refunding occurs on 11 or after April 1, 2010. 12

2. Not 14 Section later than June 1, 2010, the department of education shall notify each school district 15 receiving a mill levy supplement under W.S. 21-15-105 16 during the 2009-2010 school year of the provisions of this 17 18 act.
