1 AN ACT relating to construction contracts with public entities; clarifying application of preference requirements 2 to specified construction project delivery methods; 3 requiring bids to be open in public; and providing for an 4 effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 16-6-102(a), 16-6-103 and 16-6-707(a) are amended to read: 10 11 16-6-102. Resident contractors; preference limitation 12 13 with reference to lowest bid or qualified response; decertification; denial of application for residency. 14

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2 (a) If a contract is let by the state, any department thereof, or any county, city, town, school district, 3 community college district or other public corporation of 4 the state for the erection, construction, alteration or 5 repair of any public building, or other public structure, 6 7 or for making any addition thereto, or for any public work improvements, the contract shall be let, if 8 or advertisement for bids or request for proposal is not 9 required, to a resident of the state. Unless an alternate 10 11 design and construction delivery method is used, All bids let under this subsection including subcontractor bids, 12 13 shall be opened in public following reasonable public 14 notice. If advertisement for bids, request for qualifications or request for proposal is required, the 15 contract shall be let to the responsible certified resident 16 making the lowest bid if the certified resident's bid is 17 18 not more than five percent (5%) higher than that of the lowest responsible nonresident bidder. 19

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21 16-6-103. Limitation on subcontracting by resident

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A successful resident bidder shall not subcontract more
 than thirty percent (30%) of the <u>monetary value of</u> work
 covered by his contract to nonresident contractors.

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5 16-6-707. Construction contract preference 6 requirements; requests for proposals for construction 7 services.

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(a) Excluding contracts for professional services, 9 10 Construction management and design-build delivery 11 negotiations contracts by public entities and construction managers, including contracts for professional services, 12 shall be in accordance with residency and preference 13 14 requirements imposed under W.S. 16-6-101 through 16-6-107. As used in this section, "professional services" includes 15 preconstruction services or those services exclusively 16 involved in the project design prior to commencement of 17 18 project construction. 19

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2010.
