This appropriation shall only be 12 expended for the purpose of implementing an electronic 13 benefit transfer system for the payment of child care 14 facilities from the child care and development fund, and any remaining funds for the purpose of increasing provider 15 16 reimbursements from the child care and development fund. any other provision 17 Notwithstanding of law, this 18 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 19 other purpose. To the extent necessary, this appropriation shall be subject to approval of a state plan amendment by 20 21 the Administration of Children and Families of the United 22 States Department of Health and Human Services.
