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This chapter may be cited as the "Special District Public 1 2 Records and Meetings Act." 3 16-12-102. Definitions. 4 5 6 (a) As used in this act: 7 (i) "Director" or "district director" means a 8 9 voting member of the governing body of a special district 10 or other specified entity, regardless of what title is used 11 in the principal act; 12 13 (ii) "Principal act" means the statutes under 14 which a special district or other specified entity listed 15 under W.S. 16-12-103(a) is formed or is operating; 16 17 (iii) "This act" means W.S. 16-12-101 through 16-12-104. 18 19 20 16-12-103. Applicability to special districts and other 21 specified entities; general provisions. 22

The specific provisions of a principal 19 act or the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act are 20 21 effective and controlling to the extent they conflict with this act. 22 23

1 (c) If a proposed entity crosses county boundaries, 2 then any required filing with a county clerk shall be filed 3 with or certified to the county clerks of the counties 4 affected. Any consultation required of the county assessor 5 or county treasurer shall be made jointly by the county 6 assessor or county treasurer of each of the affected 7 counties.

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9 If an entity is authorized to promulgate rules and (d) 10 regulations or adopt ordinances or bylaws, the district 11 shall file any rules and regulations it promulgates, 12 ordinances or bylaws it adopts and any amendments thereto 13 with the county clerk for each county in which it is 14 located. No rule, regulation, ordinance or bylaw shall be 15 effective unless filed in accordance with this subsection. 16

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19 All special districts and other specified entities shall 20 file a copy of adopted minutes of all meetings, records of 21 meetings, audits, financial statements, election results, 22 budgets, rules, regulations, bylaws, rate schedules, 23 policies and employment contracts with all administrators

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1 with the county clerk in the county or counties within 2 which the entity is located annually by July 30 of each 3 year.

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16-12-104. Public meetings.

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7 (a) In addition to the requirements of W.S. 16-4-401 8 through 16-4-408, all public meetings of special districts 9 and specified entities shall be held in a location 10 accessible to the general public or made accessible to the 11 public for purposes of the meeting.

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13 (b) Notice of any meeting of a special district or 14 specified entity shall be made in compliance with W.S. 16-15 4-404.

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17 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2010.
