> A BILL for

AN ACT relating to public utilities; requiring notice by the office of consumer advocate in proceedings in which the office acts as a party; further specifying the public service commission's authority in such proceedings; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 37-2-402(a)(i) is amended to read:

37-2-402. Consumer advocate; powers and duties.
(a) The consumer advocate shall have the power to:
(i) Act as a party in any proceeding before the commission, with the same rights and subject to the same obligations and requirements and limitations on ex parte communications, including confidentiality requirements, as other parties to the proceeding;. In any proceeding in which the consumer advocate acts as a party:
(A) The authority of commission staff to conduct discovery shall not be affected;
(B) The consumer advocate shall provide notice of its intent to act as a party to other parties and to the commission and shall withdraw as a party only upon notice to the commission and other parties. The commission may specify requirements for notice under this subparagraph and may impose conditions upon the withdrawal as necessary to ensure the commission's ability to conduct the proceeding is not adversely affected.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
