Definitions. 2 3 (a) As used in this article: 4 5 6 (iii) "Gambling" means risking any property for 7 gain contingent in whole or in part upon lot, chance, the operation of a gambling device or the happening or outcome 8 9 of an event, including a sporting event, over which the person taking a risk has no control, but does not include: 10 11 12 (E) Any game, wager or transaction which is incidental to a bona fide social relationship, is 13 14 participated in by natural persons only, and in which no person is participating, directly or indirectly, 15 in 16 professional gambling; or 17 18 (I) Any wager in a card game, whether or 19 not incidental to a bona fide social relationship, which is 20 participated in by natural persons only, and in which no 21 person is participating, directly or indirectly, in

1	(xiii) "Bona fide social relationship" means a
2	relationship based on any common interest other than solely
3	the participation in the game, wager or transaction in
4	which the parties are engaged.

8	for card games. It would still require that the
9	establishment take no portion of the winnings. The second
LO	option (in paragraph (xiii)) would provide a definition for
L1	bona fide social relationship in line with the Colorado
L2	case law. Attached please find a short description of the
L3	cases that have interpreted this language. ***
