## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to dairy marketing; providing for the sale of unpasteurized milk and unpasteurized milk products; 2 specifying requirements for the sale and distribution of 3 the milk and milk products; requiring warning statements; 4 requiring registration of farms or dairies selling the milk 5 and milk products; providing for sampling of the milk; 6 making conforming amendments; authorizing rulemaking; 7 8 providing for enforcement; providing for penalties; and 9 providing for an effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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13 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-36-111 is created to read:

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2 11-36-111 Selling unpasteurized milk; testing;

3 rulemaking; enforcement; penalty.

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5 (a) A producer may register and sell unpasteurized

6 milk or milk products using unpasteurized milk provided the

7 following conditions are met:

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9 (i) The milk or milk product contains a

10 conspicuous notification that the milk or milk product is

11 not pasteurized;

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13 (ii) Information describing the standards used by

14 the farm or dairy with respect to herd health, and in the

15 production of milk from the herd, is available to the

16 department together with:

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18 (A) The results of tests performed on the

19 cows, sheep or goats that produced the milk;

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21 (B) The results of tests performed on the

22 milk; and

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1 (C) An explanation of the tests and test 2 results. 3 (b) A farm or dairy shall test the milk or milk 4 products at a frequency of at least four (4) separate 5 months during any consecutive six (6) month period. Each 6 7 batch of milk shall test negative for drugs. Milk quality tests and drug tests shall be conducted utilizing testing 8 methods approved by the department. In no event shall the 9 milk or milk products exceed the standards for bacteria, 10 11 coliform or somatic cells as established by the department. 12 13 (c) Whenever three (3) of the last five (5)14 consecutive bacteria, coliform or somatic cell tests exceeds any of the milk quality standards under subsection 15 (b) of this section, no milk shall be offered for human 16

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19 (d) Milk testing positive for drugs shall not be used 20 for human consumption.

consumption until the milk meets the standard.

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(e) All cows, sheep or goats shall be tuberculosis 1 and brucellosis free and shall be tested for tuberculosis 2 3 and brucellosis annually. 4 (f) Registration of a farm or dairy as required by 5 subsection (a) of this section shall be accomplished by 6 7 delivering to the department a written statement 8 containing: 9 10 (i) The name of the farmer, farm or dairy; 11 (ii) A valid, current address of the farmer, farm 12 13 or dairy; and 14 15 (iii) A statement that unpasteurized milk or unpasteurized milk products are being produced at the farm 16 17 or dairy. 18 19 (q) No producer of unpasteurized milk unpasteurized milk products as provided in this section 20 21 shall publish any statement that implies approval or

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endorsement by the department.

- 1 (h) The department shall be responsible for the
- 2 administration and enforcement of this section and may
- 3 promulgate and enforce rules necessary to administer this
- 4 section.

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- 6 (j) Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this section,
- 7 the department may issue a hold order to stop the
- 8 distribution of unpasteurized milk or unpasteurized milk
- 9 products when it is deemed necessary to protect human
- 10 health.

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- 12 (k) The director may bring civil actions to enjoin
- 13 violation of the provisions of this section.

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- 15 (m) Any person who violates the provisions of this
- 16 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
- 17 conviction shall be subject to a fine not exceeding seven
- 18 hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or imprisonment not to
- 19 exceed six (6) months, or by both.
