W.S. 9-2-408 by creating a new subsection 8 (d) and 9-2-413 by creating a new subsection (g) are 9 amended to read: 10 Transfer of public records to archives or 11 9-2-408. other depository agency; digital records. 12 13

1	(d) All public records which are created in digital
2	formats and are required by their legally approved
3	retention schedules to be maintained permanently shall be
4	copied to microfilm. Indexing information identifying the
5	records on the microfilm shall be included on each roll of
6	<u>film.</u>

8	9-2-413. Reproduction of public records of political
9	subdivisions.
10	
11	(g) All public records of political subdivisions
12	which are created in digital formats and are required by
13	their legally approved retention schedules to be maintained
14	permanently shall be copied to microfilm. Indexing
15	information identifying the records on the microfilm shall
16	be included on each roll of film.

18	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2011.
