A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; providing
2 an appropriation for the design, plan and construction of
3 an archives and museum storage facility; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.**

9

10 (a) Prior to June 30, 2012, the department of
11 administration and information shall develop a request for
12 proposals for plans, design and construction of a storage
13 facility for state archives and state museum collections.

1 The request for proposals shall be submitted to the state
2 building commission for approval. The state building
3 commission shall submit the approved request for
4 competitive bids. The department of state parks and
5 cultural resources shall operate the facility after
6 construction.

15 (b) There is appropriated XXX dollars (\$XXX.00) from
16 the general fund to the department of administration and
17 information. This appropriation shall be for the period
18 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending
19 June 30, 2012. This appropriation shall only be expended
20 for the purpose of this act. Notwithstanding any other
21 provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
22 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
23 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

1 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
2 2012. This appropriation shall not be included in the
3 department's 2013-2014 standard biennial budget request.

4

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
