A BILL

- 1 AN ACT relating to state parks and cultural resources;
- 2 providing for a single registration fee for snowmobiles;
- 3 providing for documentation required for registration;
- 4 repealing additional user fee provisions; providing
- 5 conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-401(a)(iii), 31-2-402(b) and
- 10 (d), 31-2-404(a)(i), (c)(i), (d) and by creating a new
- 11 subsection (g), 31-2-405(a), 31-2-406, 31-2-407,
- 31-2-408(a) and 39-17-111(c)(ii) are amended to read:

31-2-401. Definitions. 1 2 3 (a) For purposes of this act: 4 (iii) "This act" means W.S. 31-2-401 through 5 6 31-2-409 31-2-408. 7 31-2-402. Registration selling agents; application 8 9 for registration. 10 11 (b) The department of state parks and cultural 12 resources through the division of state parks and historic 13 sites shall in accordance with W.S. 36-4-123, appoint 14 selling agents to sell snowmobile registrations. and user fees. Each selling agent shall retain one dollar (\$1.00) 15 for each user fee sold under W.S. 31-2-409(a)(ii) or for 16 each registration sold. Designated department employees 17 18 may sell snowmobile registrations and user fees, but no employee shall receive any commission on registrations or 19 user registration fees collected. 20 21 (d) Except as hereafter provided, every person who 22 23 owns or uses a snowmobile which will be operated within the

state of Wyoming shall, for each snowmobile so owned or 1 2 used file or cause to be filed each year beginning July 1, any designated registration selling agent, an 3 application for registration of the snowmobile which shall 4 be in writing in duplicate. The application shall state the 5 name and address of the owner and the name of the applicant 6 7 and describe the snowmobile, including make, model, any identifying serial numbers located on the snowmobile and 8 9 whether the snowmobile will be operated for private or 10 commercial use. At the time of application, the applicant 11 shall also present proof in a form approved by the 12 department of revenue that all sales or use tax due on the 13 snowmobile have been paid of ownership of the snowmobile in 14 the form of a valid title document. Any person who 15 knowingly presents a false or fraudulent statement of proof is subject to the provisions of W.S. 6-5-303, in addition 16 17 to any penalties and interest due for nonpayment of sales 18 or use tax on the snowmobile.

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31-2-404. Amount of fee; ad valorem tax exemption; disposition of fees; duties of department of state parks and cultural resources.

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(a) Except as provided in W.S. 31-2-408, the annual 1 registration fee for a snowmobile is: 2 3 (i) For a snowmobile intended for private use 4 5 6 7 (c) The registration selling agent shall forward to the department of state parks and cultural resources the 8 9 original copy of the registration application together 10 with: 11 12 (i) Four dollars (\$4.00) Twenty-three dollars 13 (\$23.00) of each registration fee as provided for in 14 paragraph (a)(i) of this section; 15 16 (d) Except as provided in this subsection, the fees forwarded to the department of state parks and cultural 17 resources under this section shall be deposited in the 18 snowmobile trails account created by W.S. 31 2 409(c) and 19 20 may be expended by the department subject to approval by 21 the legislature subsection (g) of this section. All fees

collected under subsection (f) of this section shall be

- 1 deposited in the search and rescue account created by W.S.
- 2 19-13-301(a).

- 4 (g) There is hereby created a snowmobile trails
- 5 account. The monies collected under this section and
- 6 forwarded to the department of state parks and cultural
- 7 resources shall be deposited in the account created by this
- 8 section and may be expended by the department subject to
- 9 approval by the legislature for the administration of the
- 10 snowmobile trails program.

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- 12 31-2-405. Payment of fees; issuance of certificate
- 13 and decal; trespass warning printed on decal.

- 15 (a) Snowmobile registration fees shall be paid before
- 16 the expiration of sixteen (16) days after acquiring
- 17 ownership of a snowmobile which will be operated within the
- 18 state of Wyoming and annually prior to operation of the
- 19 snowmobile within the state. Upon receipt of the
- 20 registration fee the registration selling agent shall issue
- 21 to the owner for each snowmobile a certificate of
- 22 registration, setting forth the facts in the application,
- 23 together with a numbered decal which shall bear a

- 1 distinctive number assigned to the snowmobile and the year
- 2 of validity, which shall at all times be prominently
- 3 displayed on the snowmobile.

- 5 31-2-406. Lost, mutilated or destroyed certificate or
- 6 decal.

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- 8 In the event of loss, mutilation or destruction of any
- 9 registration certificate, or numbered decal, the owner of a
- 10 snowmobile may obtain a duplicate registration certificate
- 11 or a new numbered decal from any registration selling agent
- 12 or any authorized department of state parks and cultural
- 13 resources employee upon filing an affidavit showing the
- 14 loss, mutilation or destruction of the original
- 15 registration certificate or numbered decal and paying a fee
- 16 of one dollar (\$1.00). The registration selling agent
- 17 shall forward to the division of parks and historic sites
- 18 within the department fifty cents (\$.50) of each duplicate
- 19 registration certificate—fee to be deposited to the general
- 20 fund. It is unlawful for any person to willfully alter or
- 21 mutilate any registration certificate or numbered decal.

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23 31-2-407. Duration of certificate and number.

1 Every certificate and number issued pursuant to W.S. 2 3 31-2-401 through $\frac{31}{2} + \frac{2}{409} + \frac{31}{3} + \frac{2}{3} + \frac{409}{3} + \frac{31}{2} + \frac{2}{408}$ shall be valid from July 1 of the year designated until June 30 of the following 4 year. The use of license plates or decals issued during 5 any registration year is hereby authorized and legalized 6 7 until and including the first day of August of the next succeeding registration year. 8 9 10 31-2-408. Exemptions. 11 12 (a) The following snowmobiles are exempt from W.S. 13 31-2-401 through 31-2-407: 14 15 (i) Mobile track-laying units; and 16 17 (ii) Snowmobiles used solely for business and 18 agricultural purposes.; and 19 20 39-17-111. Distribution. 21 The department shall certify to the state 22

treasurer amounts to be credited to appropriate accounts

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- 1 based upon deductions from the taxes collected under this
- 2 article in the following order:

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- 4 (ii) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in
- 5 snowmobiles, computed by multiplying the number of
- 6 snowmobiles for which registration and user fees have been
- 7 paid during the current fiscal year under W.S.
- 8 31-2-404(a)(i) and 31-2-409(a)(ii) times sixteen dollars
- 9 and twenty-five cents (\$16.25) plus the number of gallons
- 10 of gasoline used by snowmobiles for which registration fees
- 11 have been paid during the current fiscal year under W.S.
- 12 31-2-404(a)(ii) times the current gasoline tax rate as
- 13 defined by W.S. 39-17-104(a)(i). The number of gallons
- 14 used by commercial snowmobiles shall be reported to the
- 15 department by all businesses offering commercial snowmobile
- 16 recreational leasing. The amounts computed shall be
- 17 credited to a separate account to be expended by the
- 18 department of state parks and cultural resources to improve
- 19 snowmobile trails in Wyoming;

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- 21 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-2-408(a)(iii) and 31-2-409 are
- 22 repealed.

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Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2011.
