1 AN ACT relating to veterinarians; amending definitions relating to the practice of veterinarian medicine; 2 3 increasing board member salaries; providing exceptions for emergency veterinary care; requiring continuing education; 4 increasing penalties; and providing for an effective date. 5 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 33-30-202(a) by creating a new 10 paragraph (ix), 33-30-203(a) by creating new paragraphs (xii) and (xiii), 33-30-204(e), 33-30-211 by creating a new 11 subsection (e) and 33-30-214(a) are amended to read: 12 13

33-30-202. Definitions. 1 2 3 (a) When used in this act, these words and phrases, unless the context otherwise indicates, shall be defined as 4 5 follows: 6 7 (ix) "Animal health emergency" means any event or situation involving animal disease or animal welfare 8 9 that threatens public welfare and the viability of animal 10 industries, including, but not limited to, incursion of 11 foreign animal disease, natural disaster and bioterrorism. 12 33-30-203. License required; exceptions. 13 14 (a) No person may practice veterinary medicine in the 15 state who is not a licensed veterinarian or the holder of a 16 valid temporary permit issued by the board. This act shall 17 18 not be construed to prohibit: 19 20 (xii) Any person who, without expectation of 21 compensation, provides emergency veterinary care at the 22 site in an emergency or disaster situation; 23

1	(xiii) The state veterinarian from deputizing
2	licensed veterinarians to assist as deputy state
3	veterinarians in case of an emergency as provided in W. S.
4	11-18-103(a)(ii). The state veterinarian may request the
5	assistance of licensed veterinarians from other states as
6	needed in emergency situations without requiring Wyoming
7	licensure.

9	33-30-204. Board of veterinary medicine.

11	(e) Each member of the board shall <del>be paid</del>
12	twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for each day or substantial
13	portion thereof that he is engaged in the work of the
14	board, in addition to such reimbursement for travel and per
15	diem allowance as is normally receive compensation from the
16	veterinary medicine account for each day actually spent in
17	the performance of his official board duties at the salary
18	rate provided in W.S. 28-5-101(d) and per diem and mileage
19	as allowed to state employees.

21	33-30-211. Expiration and renewal of licenses; fees;

veterinarians on active duty with armed services; duplicate licenses; continuing education.

2	(e) The renewal under subsection (a) of this section
3	shall be accompanied by evidence satisfactory to the board
4	of compliance with this chapter and completion of
5	continuing education activities as established by rules and
6	regulations of the board.

8	33-30-214. Penalty for violation; injunction.

10	(a) Any person who shall practice veterinary medicine
11	without a currently valid license or temporary permit shall
12	be-violates W.S. 33-30-101 through 33-30-215 is guilty of a
13	misdemeanor and upon conviction for a first offense shall
14	be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or
15	imprisoned for no more than ninety (90) days, punishable by
16	a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars
17	<u>*</u>
18	months, or both. fined and imprisoned; provided that Each
19	act of such unlawful practice shall constitute a distinct
20	and separate offense.
