1 AN ACT relating to Medicaid; providing that authorized

4 matching funds to phase in Medicaid eligibility increases;

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxx) and by creating a
10 new paragraph (xxxi) is amended to read:

12 **42-4-103. Authorized services and supplies.**

1 (a) Services and supplies authorized for medical
2 assistance under this chapter include:

4 (xxx) Programs and services provided under the
5 school health program~~;~~

7 (xxxi) Preventive health care services, to the
8 extent authorized by the Patient Protection and Affordable
9 Care Act, P.L. 111-148, and the Health Care and
10 Reconciliation Act of 2010, P.L. 111-152.

11
12 **Section 2.** The department of health in its
13 proposed 2012 supplemental budget request and 2013-2014
14 standard biennial budget request shall apply the proceeds
15 of any increase in the federal funds matching rate,
16 resulting from the inclusion of preventive health care
17 services pursuant to W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxxi), to offset the
18 cost of phasing in Medicaid enrollment eligibility
19 increases otherwise required to be implemented in 2014
20 under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, P.L.
21 111-148, and the Health Care and Reconciliation Act of
22 2010, P.L. 111-152.

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
