The purpose of the meeting is to continue the Committee's interim work, as assigned by the Legislature's Management Council. The first day of the meeting the Committee will review draft legislation authorizing the Military Department, Veterans Commission, Department of Health and Construction Department to move forward with plans and design for veterans' home skilled nursing care. The Committee will also review draft legislation designating Wyoming Purple Heart Day and will receive reports regarding federal or judicial developments affecting the military or veterans. The second day of the meeting the Committee will review draft legislation regarding calculating vehicle registration depreciation fees, using a portion of fees to upgrade technology, asking Congress to allow 18 to 21 year old commercial drivers' license drivers to cross state lines, generating revenue with Yellowstone specialty license plates and increasing highway safety by amending the move over requirement. The Committee will also hear updates regarding WyoLink and I-80. Following each topic, the Committee will accept public comment.
