ALLEN SWORN IN TO REPRESENT HOUSE DISTRICT 33

CHEYENNE – Jim Allen, of Lander, was sworn in as a member of the 57th Wyoming Legislature on Friday, April 16, 2004 in Cheyenne. Wyoming Supreme Court Chief Justice, William Hill, administered the oath of office and presided over the ceremony in the House Chambers at the Capitol in front of members of Allen’s family, friends, and legislative staff. Representative Allen was joined during the ceremony by his wife, Mary, and his daughters, Christin, Holly, and Jessie.

The Fremont County Commissioners appointed Allen on April 6, 2004 to fill the vacant House District 33 seat of long-time Representative Harry Tipton, who passed away on March 11, 2004 after a long battle with cancer. Representative Allen, a native of Lander, is a rancher and outfitter on his family’s Diamond Four Ranch in the Wind River Range. – **END** –
