practices for the humane treatment of animals. 1 The owner 2 of the animal shall be liable for all costs associated with 3 the final disposition of the animal under this subsection. 4 5 (e) If a bond has been posted in accordance with subsection (b) or (c) of this section, the agency employing 6 the officer, or the board, may draw from the bond the 7 actual costs as described in subsection (b) of this 8 9 section, from the date of initial impoundment to the date 10 of final disposition of the animal. 11 12 Section 2. W.S. 11-29-106 is amended to read: 13 11-29-106. Livestock board; authority to 14 prevent cruelty; penalty for interference with officer. 15 16 17 Any peace officer, or agent or officer of the board may lawfully interfere to prevent the perpetration of any act 18 of cruelty upon any animal in his presence. Any person who 19 20 interferes with, obstructs or resists any peace officer or 21 officer or agent of the board in the discharge of his duty shall be fined not less than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) 22 thousand five 23 nor more than one hundred dollars

(\$1,500.00), or imprisoned not more than one (1) year, or 1 2 both. 3 Section 3. W.S. 11-29-107 is repealed. 4 5 Section 4.
