A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for free
2 resident disabled veterans lifetime conservation stamps;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-2-306(a)(intro) and by creating a
8 new subsection (c) is amended to read:

9

10 **23-2-306. Conservation stamp; exemptions.**

12 (a) Subject to ~~subsection~~subsections (b) and (c) of
13 this section and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701,
14 each sportsman licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or
15 23-2-201 shall purchase a single conservation stamp for ten
16 dollars (\$10.00) which shall be valid for one (1) calendar
17 year and in the possession of any person exercising rights

1 under any fishing or hunting license issued pursuant to
2 W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201. Holders of pioneer
3 licenses as defined under W.S. 23-1-705(d) and (e), of
4 special limited fishing permits issued under W.S. 23-2-207
5 and holders of licenses only under W.S. 23-2-101(j)(v) and
6 (vi), 23-2-201(d)(vi) and (vii) and 23-2-201(f) are exempt
7 from the provisions of this section. Revenues collected
8 from the sale of each stamp under this subsection shall be
9 deposited as follows:

11 (c) Any resident disabled veteran who receives fifty
12 percent (50%) or more service connected disability
13 compensation from the United States department of veteran's
14 affairs may apply to the department for a resident disabled
15 veteran's lifetime conservation stamp. Application shall
16 include proof of residency required under W.S. 23-2-101(a),
17 certification of the applicant's service connected
18 disability and other information required by rule and
19 regulation of the commission. Notwithstanding subsections
20 (a) and (b) of this section, a disabled veteran's lifetime
21 conservation stamp shall be issued to an eligible applicant
22 without payment of any fee.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2007.
