A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to law enforcement retirement; authorizing
2 law enforcement officers to purchase service credits as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-432 by creating a new subsection
8 (n) is amended to read:

10 **9-3-432. Law enforcement officers; contributions;**
11 **benefit eligibility; service and disability benefits; death**
12 **benefits; benefit options.**

14 (n) Any law enforcement officer may elect to purchase
15 up to five (5) years of service credit for full-time
16 employment in law enforcement performed for another state

1 or political subdivision of another state, the federal
2 government or in Wyoming for a public law enforcement
3 agency. The purchase of prior service credits may not be
4 made by the officer if he has a vested retirement benefit
5 from the prior full-time employment in law enforcement.
6 Any member electing to purchase service credit shall pay
7 into the account a single lump-sum amount equal to the
8 actuarial equivalent of the benefits to be derived from the
9 service credit computed on the basis of actuarial
10 assumptions approved by the board and the individual's
11 attained age and average salary for the highest three (3)
12 continuous years of covered service.

13

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
16 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
17 Constitution.
