for

1 AN ACT relating to speed limits; providing for enforcement
2 of speed limits in safety zones established in the vicinity
3 of schools; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-301(b)(i) is amended to read:

9 **31-5-301. Maximum speed limits.**

11 (b) Except when a special hazard exists that requires
12 lower speed for compliance with subsection (a) of this
13 section, the limits specified in this subsection or
14 established as otherwise authorized shall be maximum lawful
15 speeds and no person shall drive a vehicle on a highway at
16 a speed in excess of maximum limits:

2 (i) Twenty (20) miles per hour when passing a
3 school building, or the grounds thereof, within any other
4 area or space in the vicinity of a school designated as a
5 school zone or a school crossing if appropriate signs
6 giving notice of that limit are erected;

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
