Golf clubs-liquor licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcohol; providing for golf clubs with
2 retail liquor licenses to dispense alcohol anywhere on the
3 premises; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-5-201(a) and (g) is amended to
8 read:

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10 **12-5-201. Location, regulation and restrictions as to**
11 **place of sale; inspections; additional dispensing rooms.**

13 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
14 principal place in which alcoholic liquor and malt
15 beverages are sold under a license shall be located in one
16 (1) room upon the premises for which the license is issued
17 and as approved by the licensing authority. Upon payment of

1 an additional license fee equal to two-thirds (2/3) of the
2 fee paid for the original license, a licensee may have and
3 maintain one (1) additional dispensing room in the same
4 building under the authority of the original license.
5 Alcoholic beverages secured in the licensed room by a
6 server may be served only in the building in which the
7 licensed room is located and in an immediately adjacent
8 fenced or enclosed area as approved by the local licensing
9 authority. This area shall not be in another building and
10 shall be located on the licensed premises. Only alcoholic
11 and malt beverages, nonalcoholic beverages, food, tobacco
12 and alcoholic liquor and malt beverage promotional sales
13 items sold to the licensee bearing the name and trademark
14 of the alcoholic liquor and malt beverage firm or company
15 whose product the item is advertising, may be sold and
16 served in the licensed room. The licensing authority shall,
17 as often as necessary, inspect the licensed room and
18 adjoining rooms where alcoholic beverages are served to
19 insure that the licensee is in compliance with sanitation
20 and fire hazard requirements and other applicable laws. A
21 licensee may separate the facility for the sale of
22 alcoholic liquor and malt beverages for off-premise
23 consumption from the facility used to serve customers for
24 on-premise consumption without payment of an additional

1 fee. A separated facility for making sales for off-premise
2 consumption shall be located adjoining the facility for
3 making sales for on-premise consumption. The two (2)
4 facilities may be separated by a glass or other suitable
5 partition.

7 (g) Any golf club as defined by W.S.
8 12-1-101(a)(iii)(D) which holds a retail liquor license or
9 a club limited retail liquor license under W.S. 12-4-301
10 may dispense alcoholic beverages from any location within
11 the boundaries of the golf club premises. The premises
12 shall be a single property within a contiguous boundary
13 upon which the golf club is located and which shall be
14 identified in the license. Subsections (a) through (c) and
15 (e) of this section do not apply to golf clubs as defined
16 by W.S. 12-1-101(a)(iii)(D) which are holders of a retail
17 liquor license or a club limited retail liquor license with
18 respect to alcoholic beverages dispensed within the
19 contiguous boundaries of the golf club premises, ~~for which~~
20 ~~a club limited retail liquor license is issued,~~ except that
21 any location on the golf club premises where alcoholic
22 beverages are dispensed as approved by the licensing
23 authority shall comply with applicable sanitation and fire
24 hazard requirements and other applicable laws. The

1 licensing authority shall, as often as necessary, inspect
2 the licensed location where alcoholic beverages are
3 dispensed to ensure that the licensee is in compliance with
4 sanitation and fire hazard requirements.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
9 Constitution.
