A BILL

for

1 AN ACT providing an appropriation for the alleviation of
2 specified conditions on the Wind River Indian Reservation
3 through education programs; imposing conditions upon the
4 expenditure of appropriated funds; transferring funds to
5 the governor's office; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

11 (a) The legislature finds that:

12

13 (i) Conditions of severe unemployment, poverty
14 and lack of adequate job skills exist on the Wind River
15 Indian Reservation;

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1 (ii) Educational programs provided by the
2 Eastern Shoshone and the Northern Arapaho Indian Tribes
3 address these conditions on the reservation;

4
5 (iii) The Shoshone and Arapaho Indian Tribes are
6 sovereign nations whose members are also citizens of the
7 United States and residents of Wyoming;

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9 (iv) With assistance from the state of Wyoming,
10 the joint business council of the Eastern Shoshone and
11 Northern Arapaho Indian Tribes will be capable of
12 continuing efforts to address conditions existing on the
13 reservation through the provision of programs addressing
14 the special educational needs of Indian students. The
15 maintenance of these special educational programs unique to
16 Indian students is of mutual benefit to the tribes and to
17 the state, reducing future financial needs of those
18 students as tribal members and as Wyoming residents for
19 public education, job services, substance abuse services
20 and income supplements.

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22 (b) Twenty-six thousand three hundred sixteen dollars
23 (\$26,316.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the
24 office of the governor for the fiscal biennium to be used

1 for a cost of living increase to the budget for Saint
2 Stephens school. One-half (1/2) of the funds shall be used
3 for each year of the biennium. The office of the governor
4 shall provide the funds under this section through
5 amendment of existing contracts or creation of new
6 contracts with the joint business council of the Eastern
7 Shoshone and Northern Arapaho Indian Tribes whereby the
8 funds appropriated under this section shall be conveyed to
9 the joint business council to be expended by the joint
10 business council for program enhancements, services for
11 students at risk of failure in school and other services
12 essential to the success and welfare of students.

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14 (c) There is transferred to the office of the
15 governor from the department of education three hundred
16 eighty-four thousand one hundred ten dollars (\$384,110.00)
17 for funding for Saint Stephens school. This transfer shall
18 be a type 1 transfer, pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1707(b)(i) and
19 shall include the transfer of all positions, personnel,
20 property, contracts and funds associated with the funds
21 appropriated under this section.

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23 (d) As part of the contract under which funds are
24 provided under this section the joint business council

1 shall agree to report to the joint appropriations interim
2 committee, the joint education interim committee and the
3 select committee on tribal relations on the expenditure of
4 funds under this section and on the impact of the
5 expenditures on student performance. The report shall be
6 made not later than June 30, 2007.

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
